Wisconsin DPI	CLC Renewals (33 sites)	1,850,000	<p>21st Century Community Learning Centers are programs designed to provide students with academic support, enrichment, and youth development opportunities in an after school setting. "CLCs support and strengthen student outcomes in schools with an improvement status such as Title I focus. CLCs...enroll students who may be at risk for academic failure, dropping out of school, involvement in criminal or delinquent activities, or who lack strong positive role models" (WI DPI).</p> <p>The current cohort of DPI funding proposals includes requests from 33 sites, ranging from K-8 locations to high schools. Records project the funding request at \$1,895,000 and approximately 7,000 students throughout the city of Milwaukee are projected to participate in programming at these sites.</p>
