Whole Kids Foundation	Whole Kids Foundation (Hawthorne)	3,000	Grant funds will be used for Hawthorne to support a new or existing edible educational garden located at either a k-12 school. The school garden will be used in science activities, to increase school engagement, and students living a healthy lifestyle.
US Dept of Agriculture	USDA Fresh Fruits and Vegetables	1,648,100	Grant funds will be used participating schools to provide their students and classroom teachers with free fresh fruit and vegetable snacks, accompanied by a nutrition lesson, two days per week. The primary focus of this grant is nutrition education. We are anticipating 80 elementary schools will participate in this grant.
Wisconsin DPI	WI DPI State and Other Drug Abuse Program (Dept. of Curricu)	45,000	Grant funds will be used to create a comprehensive program that reaches as many students as possible on a wide variety of AODA issues. This project provides professional development to Milwaukee Public Schools staff and direct services to students that develop their resiliency, educate them on high-risk behaviors and teach the skills necessary to avoid many of the risks students face every day.
Wisconsin DPI	WI DPI School-Based Mental Health Services Grant	75,000	Grant funds will be used to fund partnerships with community mental health providers to provide services to students in the schools. The School Community Partnership Mental Health program allows providers to continue providing non-billable services such as parent and staff workshops, parent and staff consultation, and co-led small groups at schools where they also provide therapy services.
Meemic Foundation	Meemic Foundation (Craig Montessori)	295	Grant funds will be used for Craig Montessori to purchase a standing computer desk for a classroom.
PLACEHOLDER	Turnaround Arts 2021 Emergency COVID Summer Block Fund	9,000	Grant funds will support a mural, which will add to the school's culture of existing community murals and art in the building. The courtyard will be used by classes as an outdoor learning space, and the arts resource center will be used by classes to engage students in the various art forms and integrate those art forms into non-arts classroom content areas. The schools awarded funds were Lancaster, Sherman, Martin Luther King, and Roosevelt Middle
