AIR QUALITY REPORT

At its March 23, 2021, Special Meeting, the Milwaukee Board of School Directors adopted the Administration's Reopening Plan with a number of provisions, including monthly reports regarding air quality, with priority given for classrooms and schools without window access to outside air.

The Department of Facilities and Maintenance Services (DFMS) continues to monitor mechanical systems throughout the district and perform any necessary repairs to make sure MPS buildings are safe and clean. DFMS is contracting consultants to update documentation necessary to complete testing and balancing of the mechanical systems along with outside contractors and inhouse staff performing the task.

The Administration will continue to pursue measures in assuring good air quality in MPS buildings and report to the Board monthly. The report will include updates on procuring consultants and status of findings during the site investigations as part of their scope, steps toward procuring contractors to perform testing and balancing and identify any deficiencies in mechanical systems, and then evaluate potential deficiencies and establish a remediation plan if necessary. This defined process equates to performing a ventilation audit.
