

**EXPULSION ORDER**

The Independent Hearing Officer of the Milwaukee Board of School Directors met at **9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 31, 2025**, in Room 136 of Milwaukee Public Schools' Central Services Building, to give hearing regarding the recommendation of Mr. Matthew Boswell, Senior Director of the Department of Student Services, to expel ••••, who was accused of **Repeated Violation-Endangerment of Physical Safety/Mental Well-being at Marshall High School on Monday, March 3, 2025**.

After hearing testimony and taking evidence the Officer appointed by the Board of School Directors finds as follows:

By **Repeated Violation-Endangerment of Physical Safety/Mental Well-being at Marshall High School on Monday, March 3, 2025**, •••• engaged in conduct while at school and while under the supervision of a school authority, which endangered the property, health and safety of others while at school and under the supervision of a school authority. Such conduct is grounds for expulsion under Wisconsin State Statute 120.13 (1)(c).

Based on these findings, the recommendation of the Senior Director of the Department of Student Services, to expel •••• is reasonably justified; and the interests of the Milwaukee Public Schools demand that this student be expelled until **June 15, 2026**. Reinstatement into the Milwaukee Public Schools will be through the Department of Student Services.

The Officer also directs the Administration to provide the following services during the expulsion period.

Such conduct is grounds for expulsion under Wisconsin State Statute 120.13 (1)(c).
