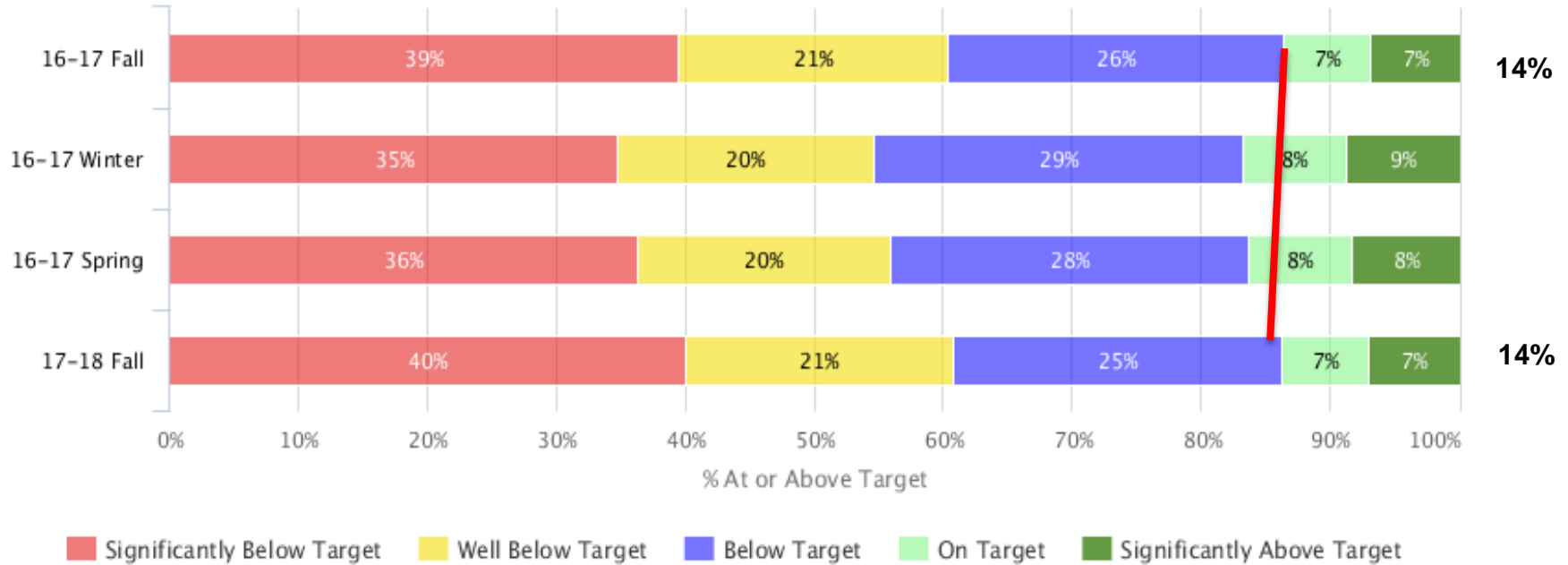
Fall 2017

- Math – 75th Percentile

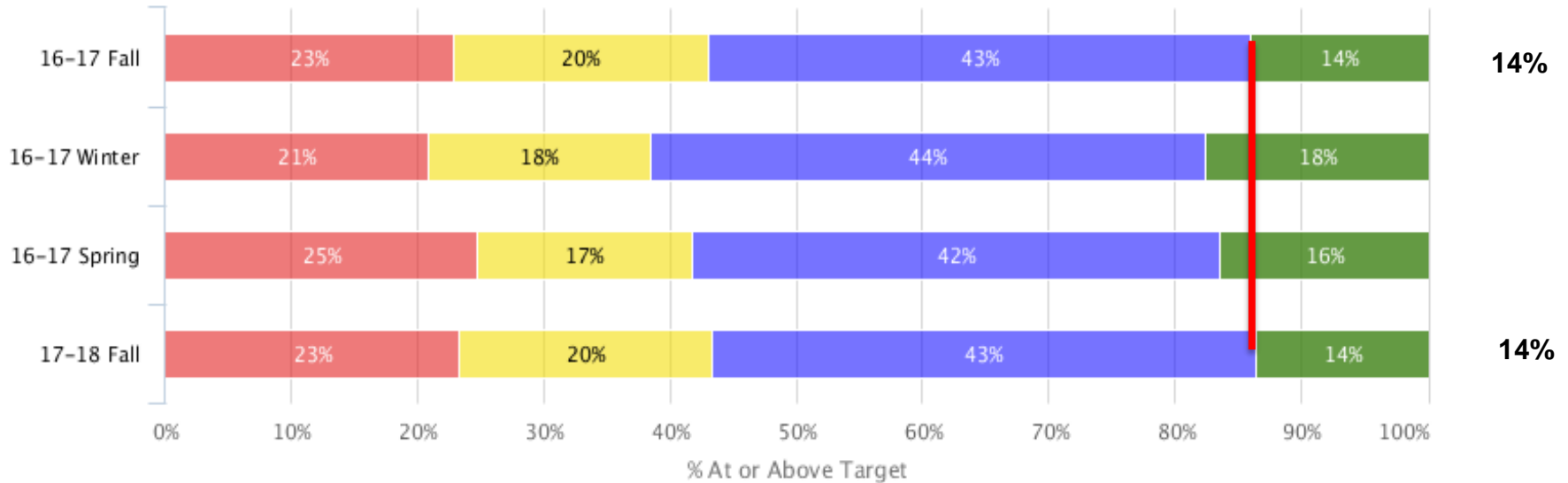
Fall 2017

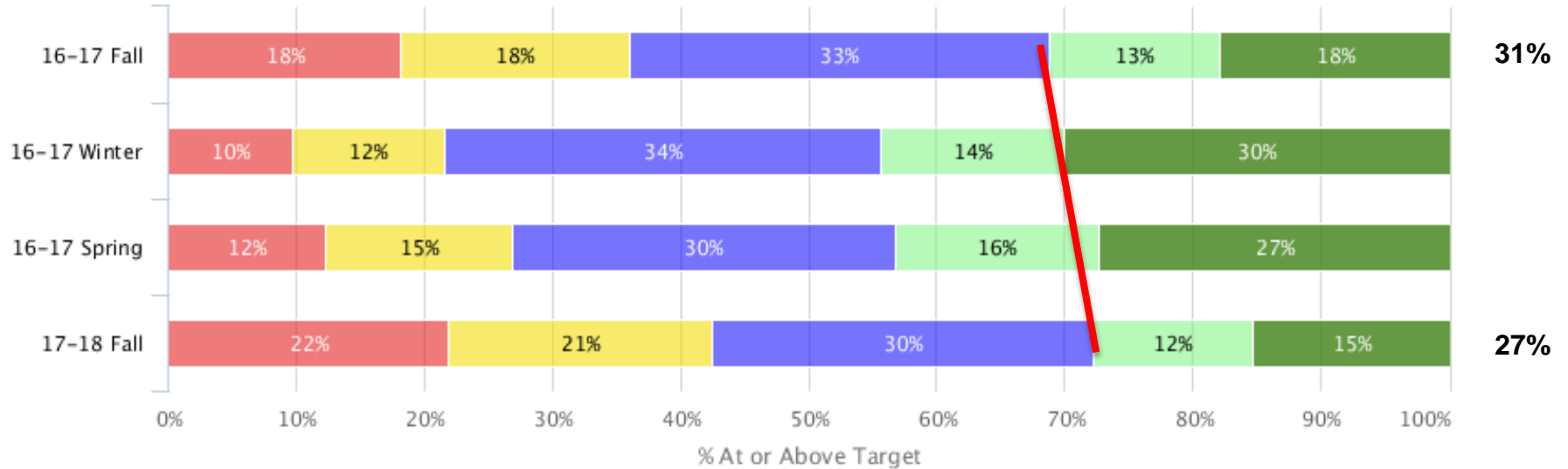


STAR Math



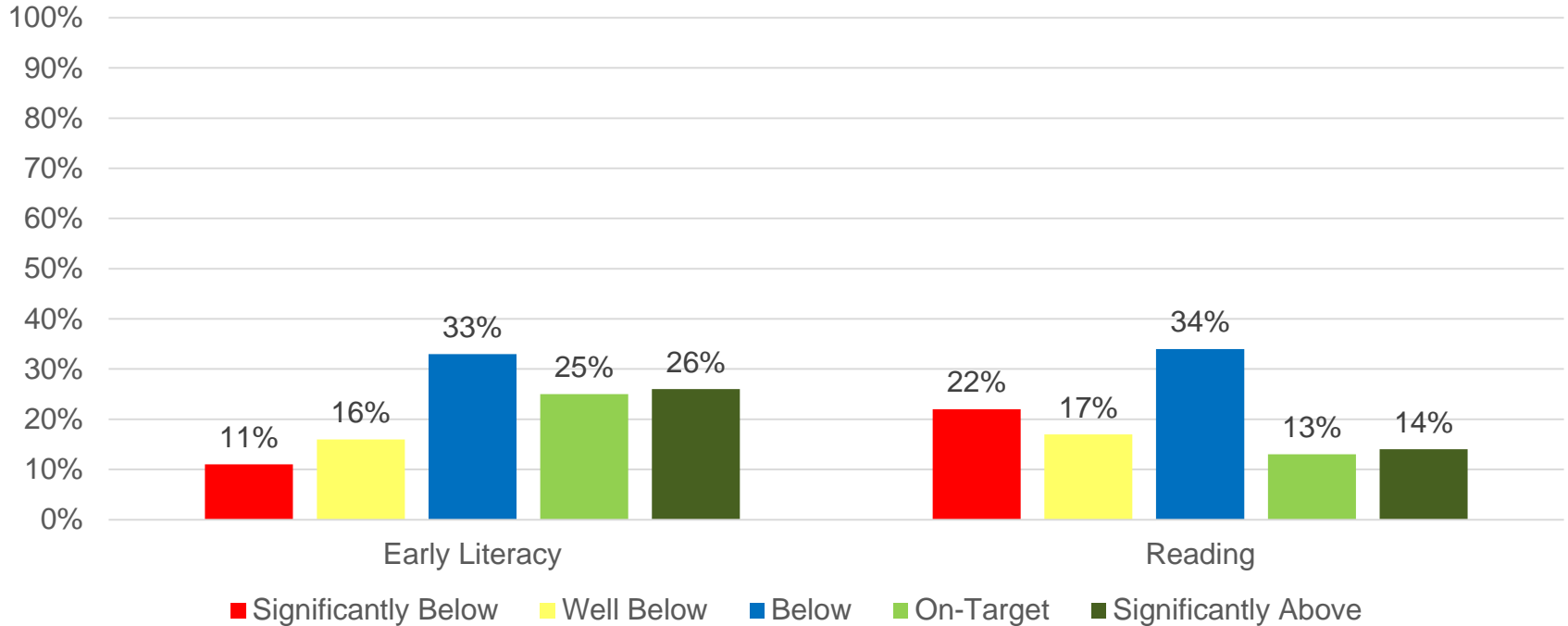

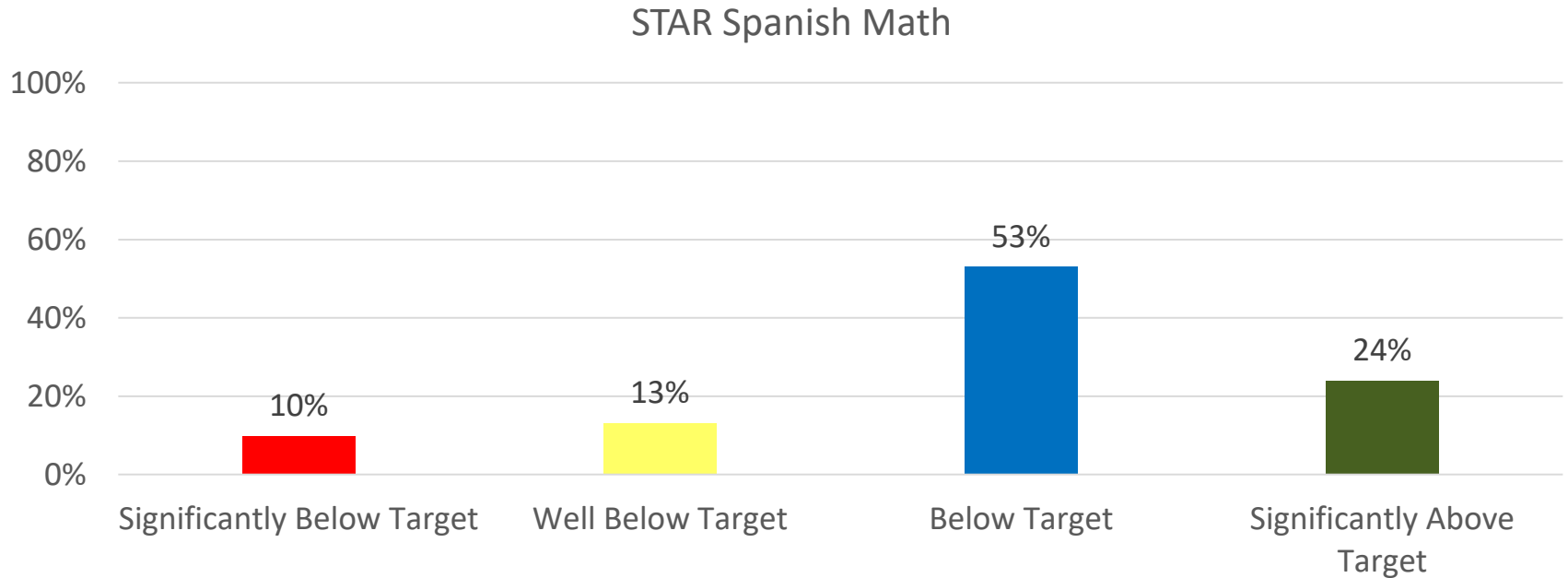

STAR Spanish – Math



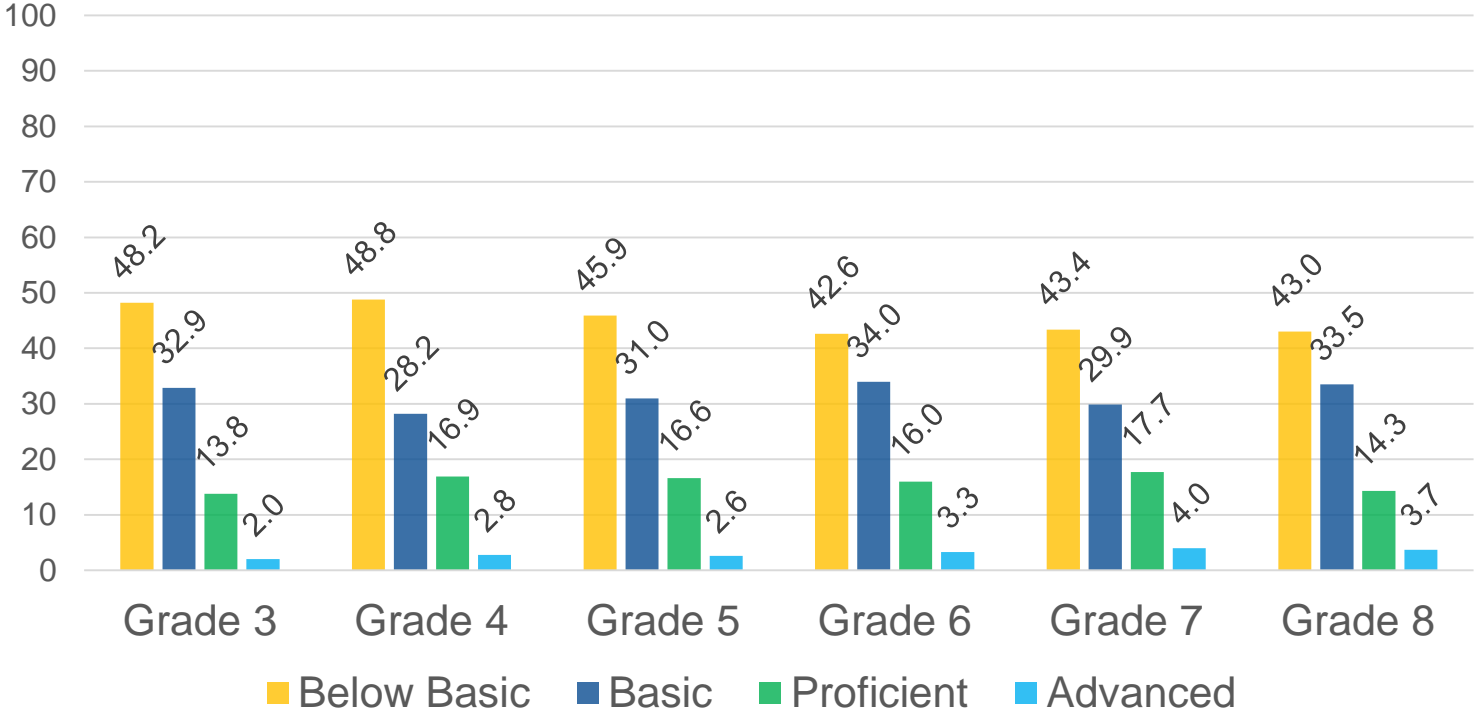


WI Forward Performance Levels

Below Basic	Student demonstrates minimal understanding of and ability to apply the knowledge and skills for his or her grade level that are associated with college content-readiness

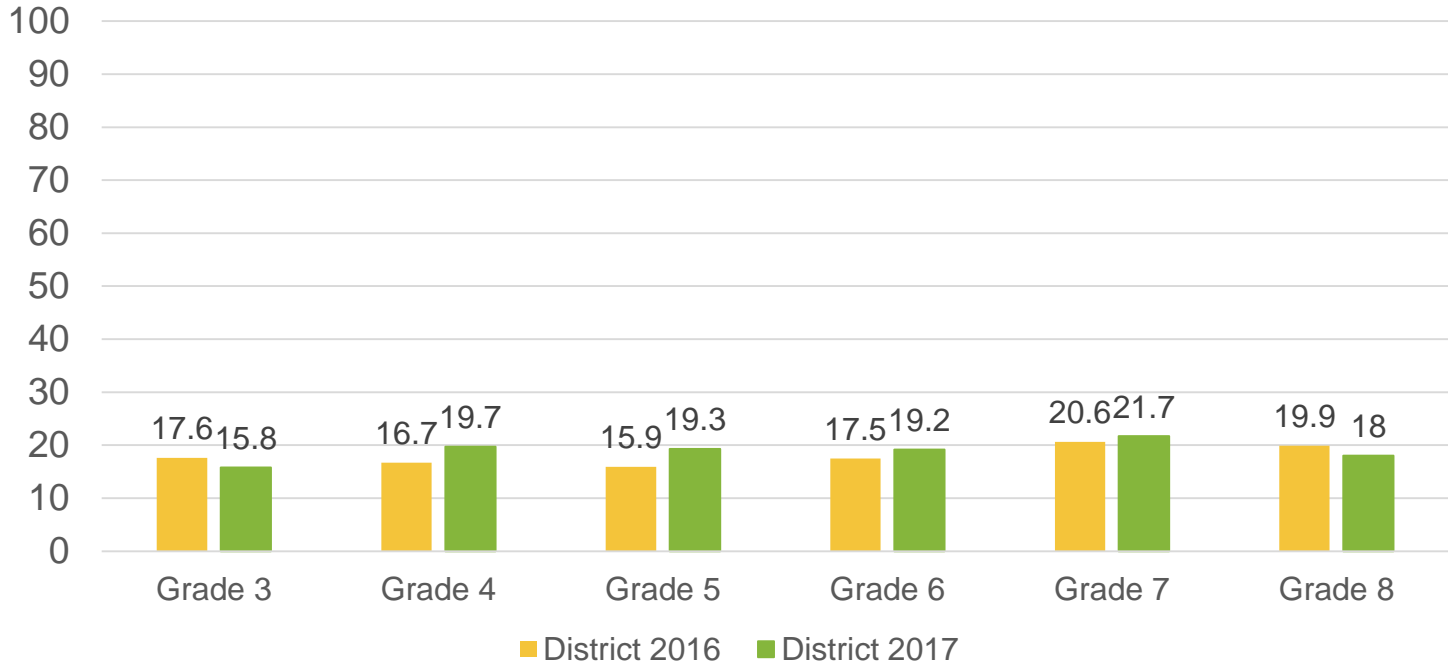
Wisconsin Forward 2017 ELA Results

Percent Advanced Increasing as grade level increases



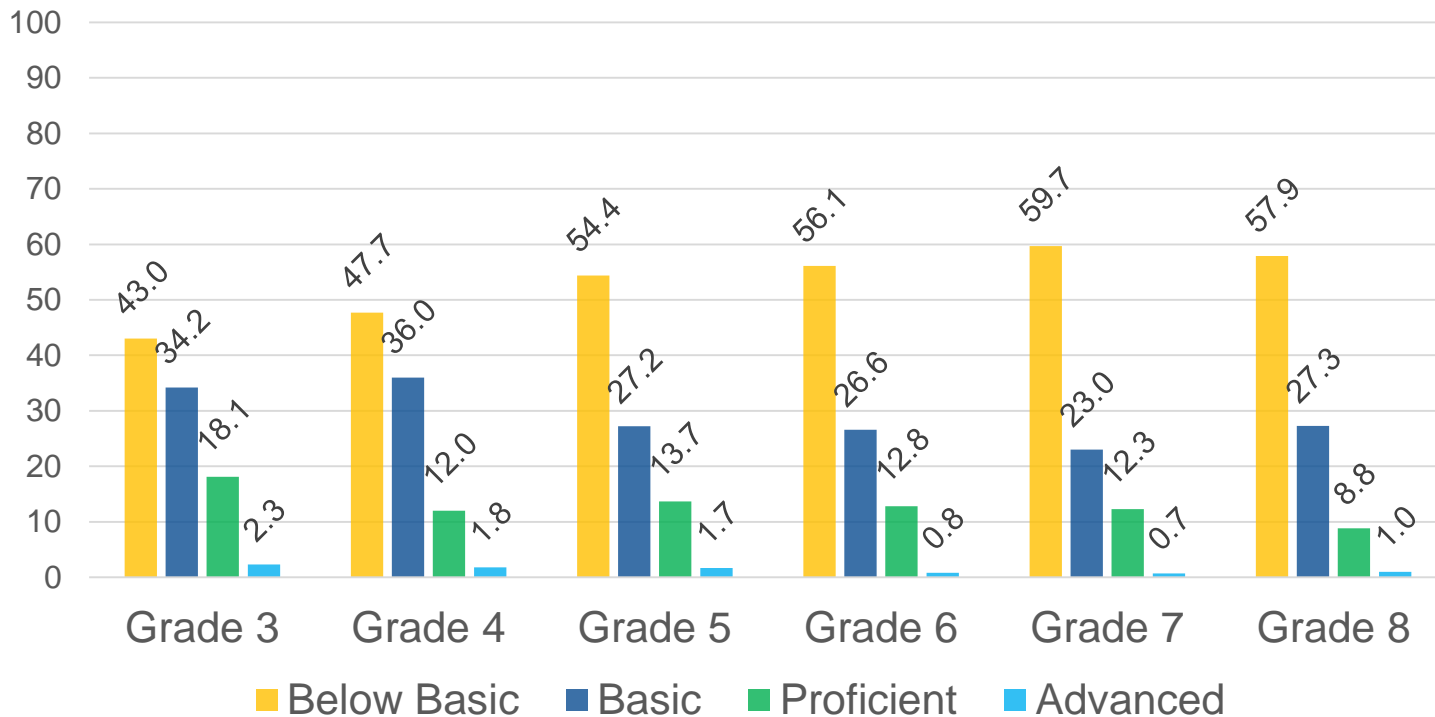
ELA Two-Year Comparison to State

2017 Math Results

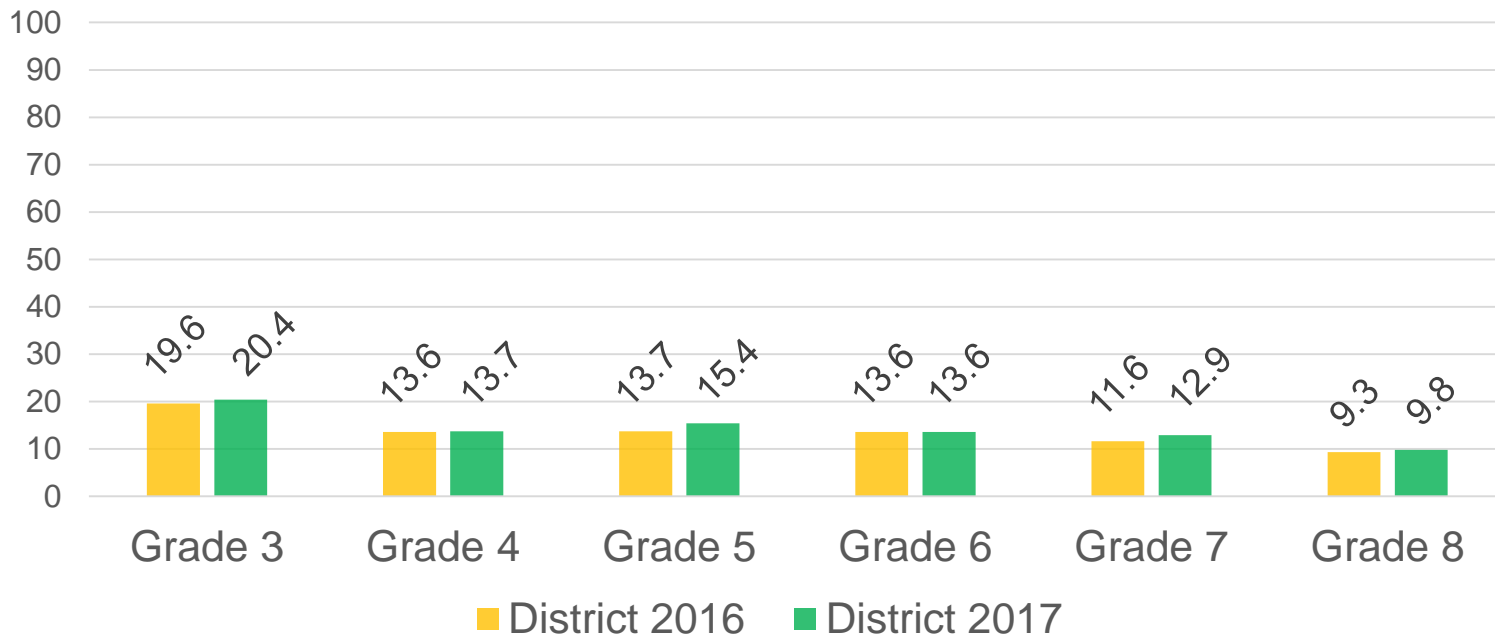
Students performing below basic increases as grade levels increase

Percent Proficient & Advanced

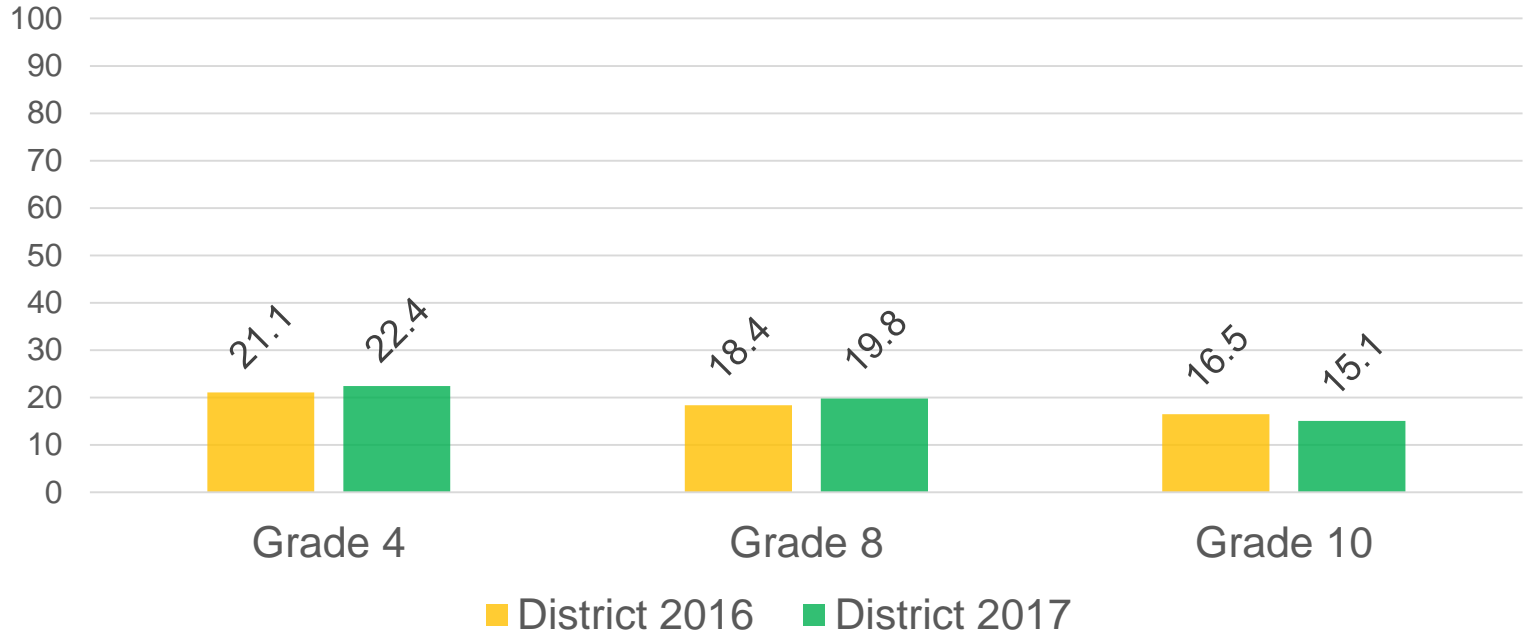
Math performance increased from 2016 to 2017 in grades 3, 4, 5, 7 and 8

Percent Proficient & Advanced

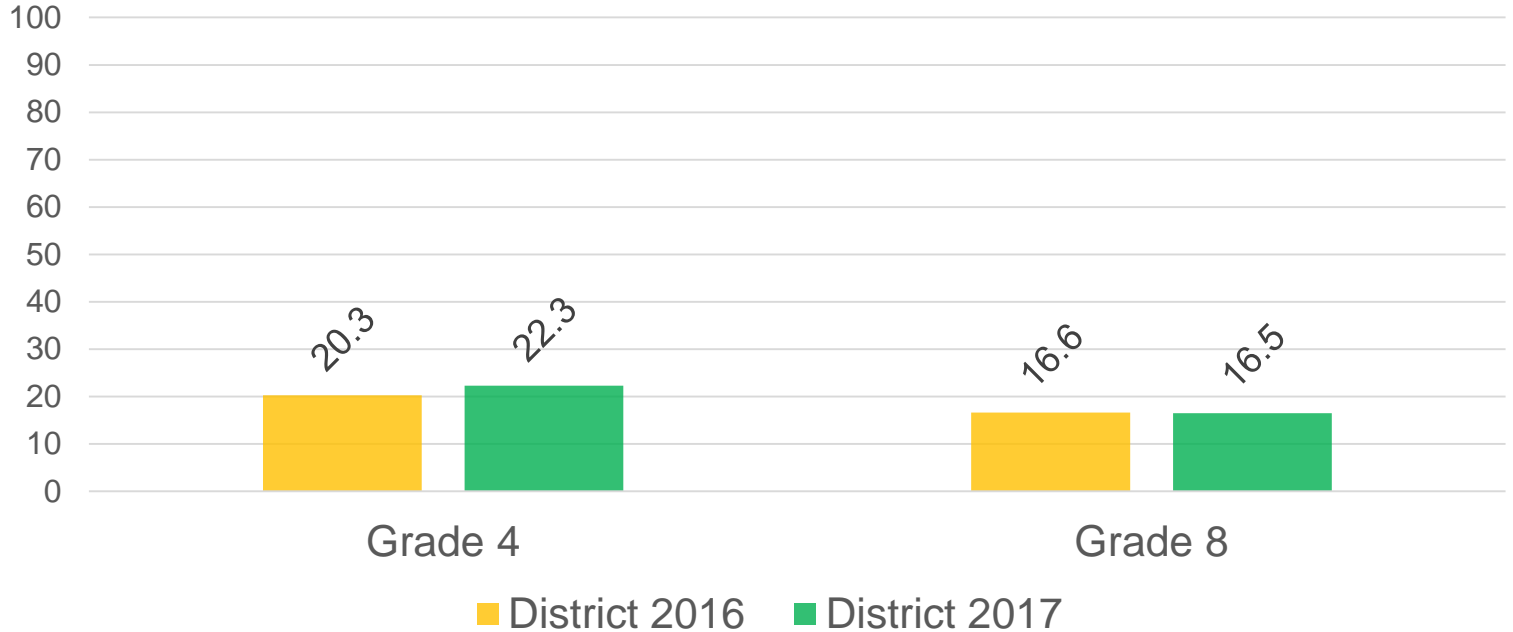
Social Studies performance increased from 2016 to 2017 in grades 4, and 8

Percent Proficient & Advanced

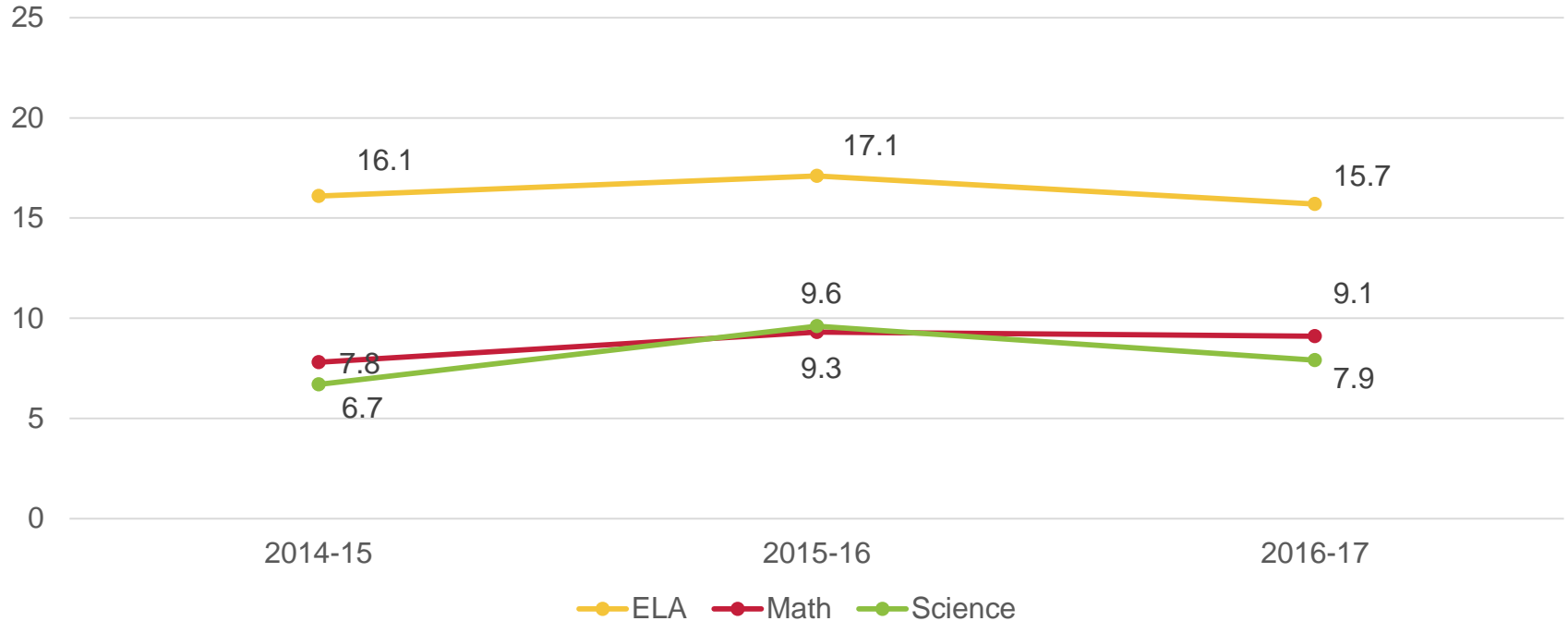
Science performance increased from 2016 to 2017 in grade 4

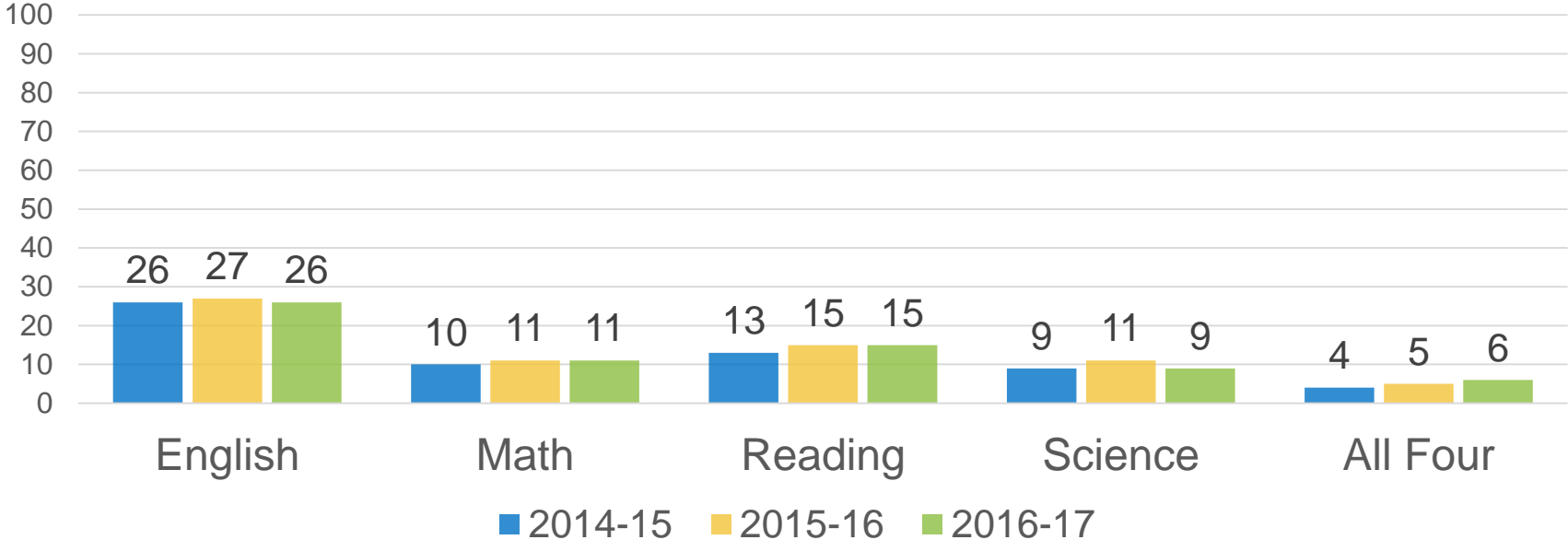

ACT Trend Proficient or Above



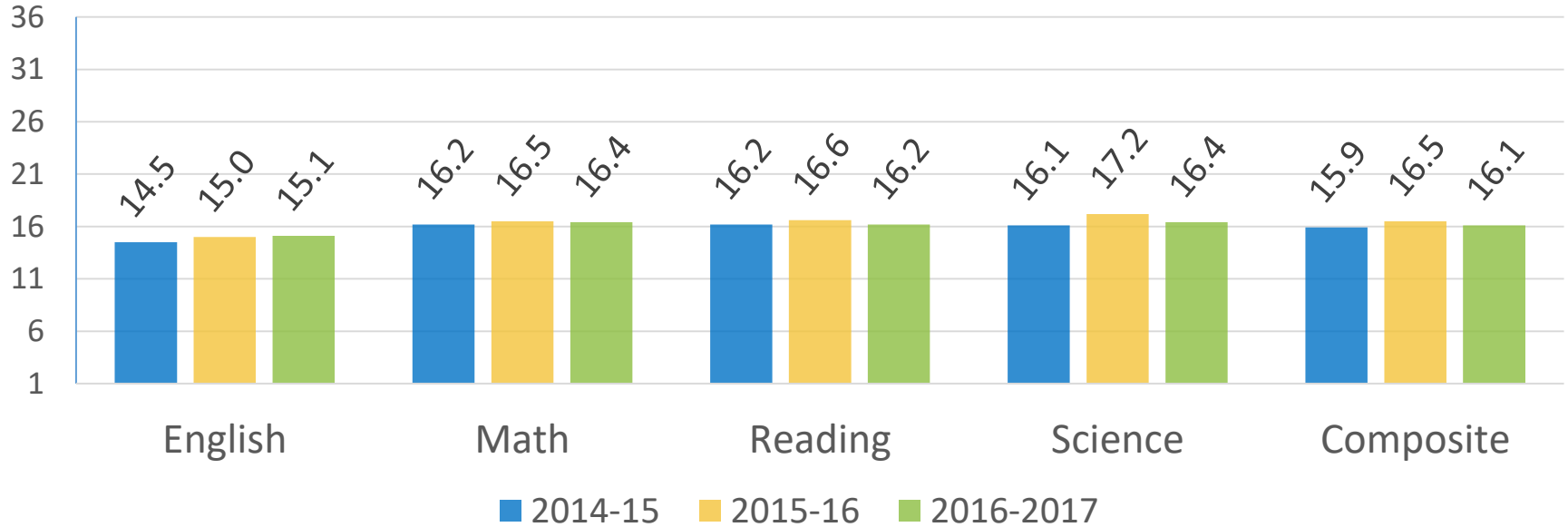
District: ACT Percent College Ready

ACT Writing

- Beginning in fall 2016, ACT reports Writing Test scores on a range of 2-12, with 12 being the highest possible score
- The Writing score is the average of the four writing domain scores (Ideas and Analysis, Development and Support, Organization, and Language Use and Conventions) which are also scored on a scale of 2-12
- The district scores for 2015-16 and 2016-17 are comparable
- The 2016-17 score is 5.7

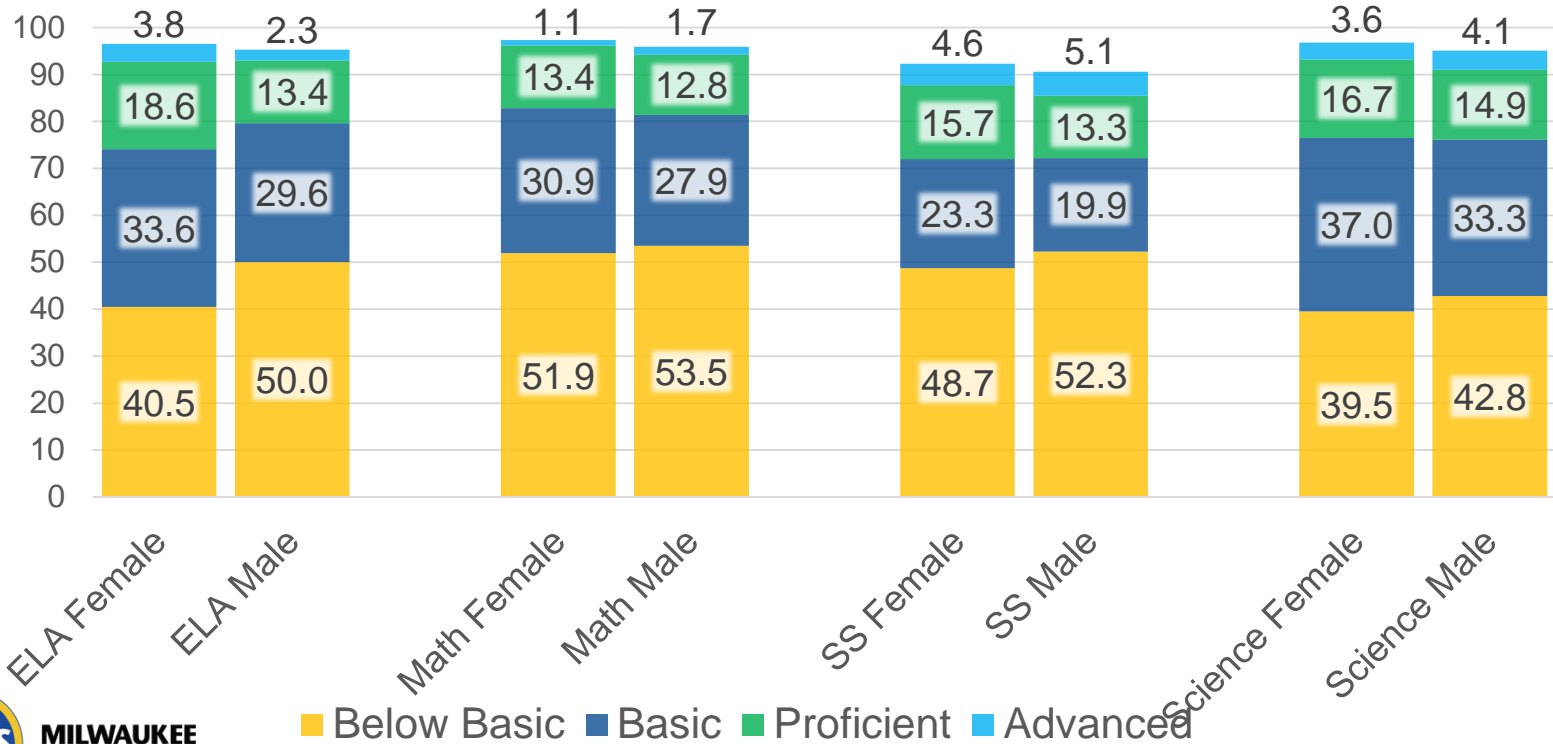

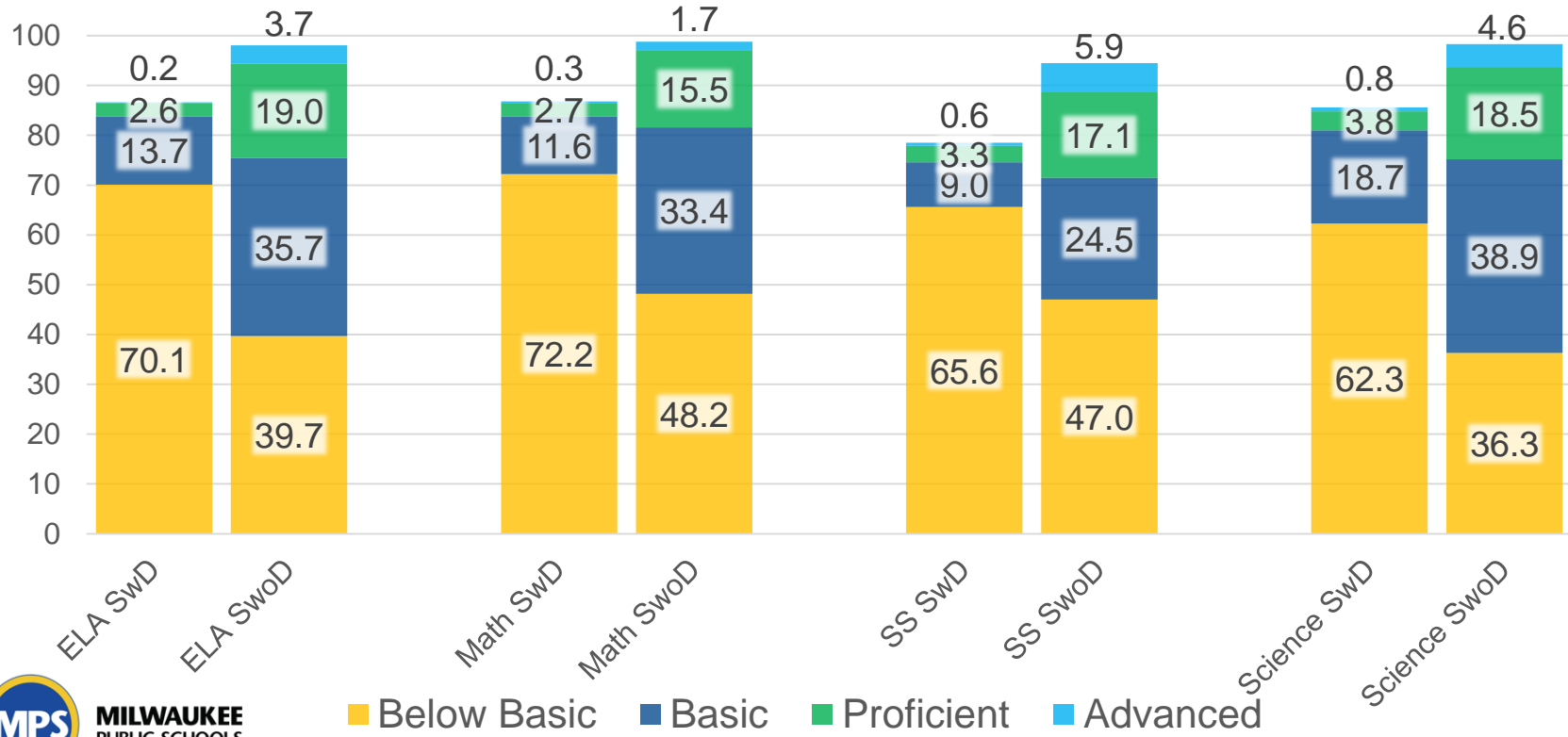

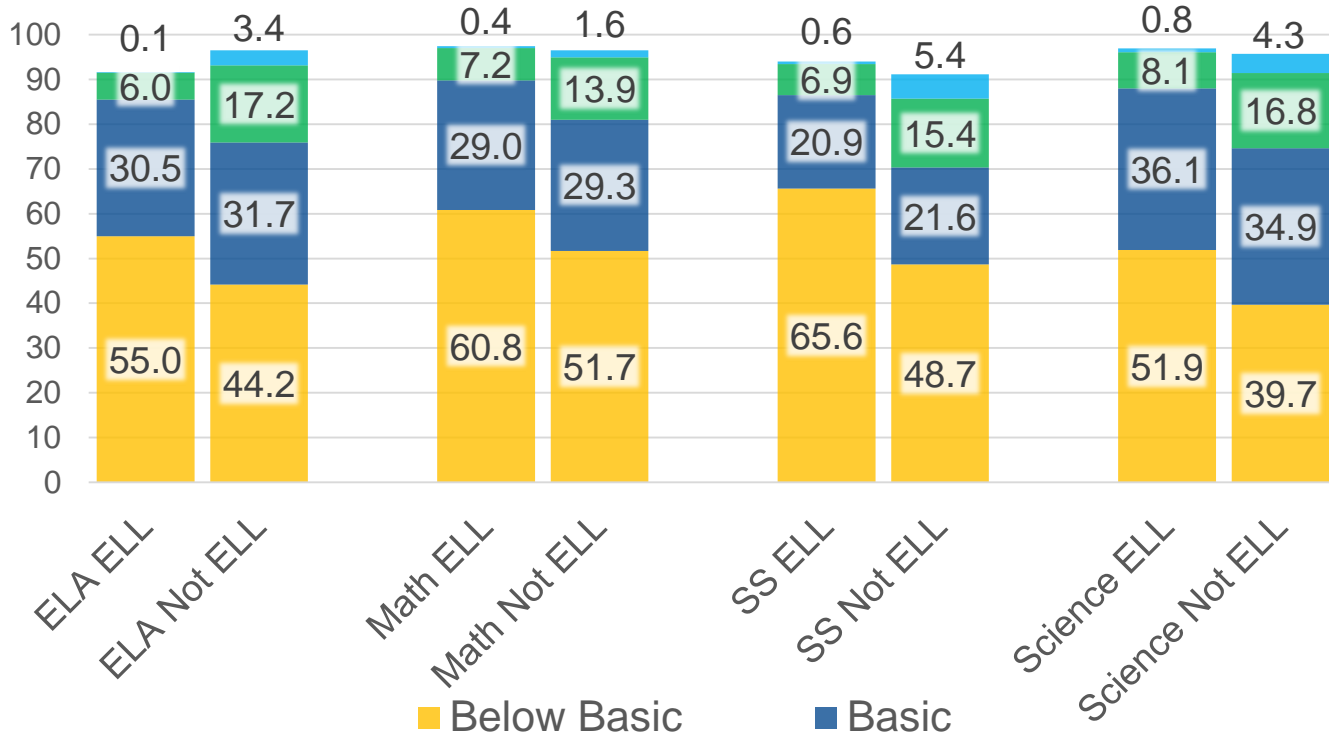
2017 Demographic Breakdowns: Gender



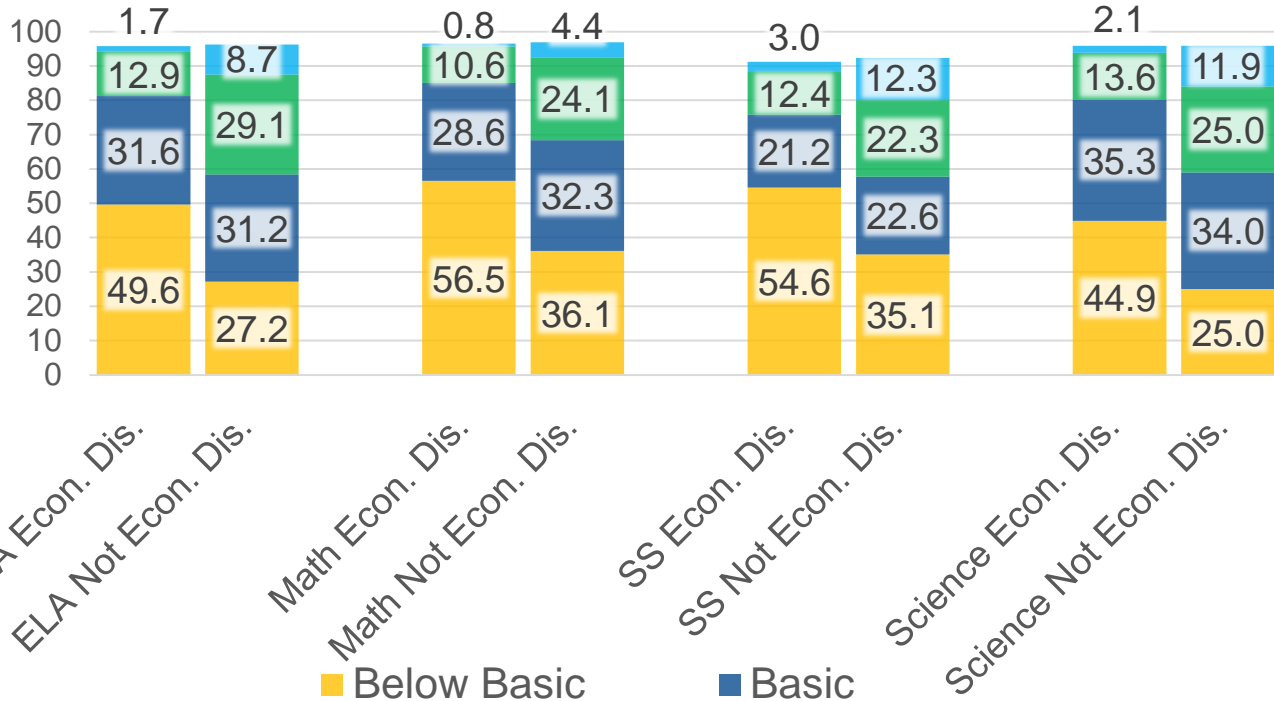
2017 Demographic Breakdowns: Disability Status



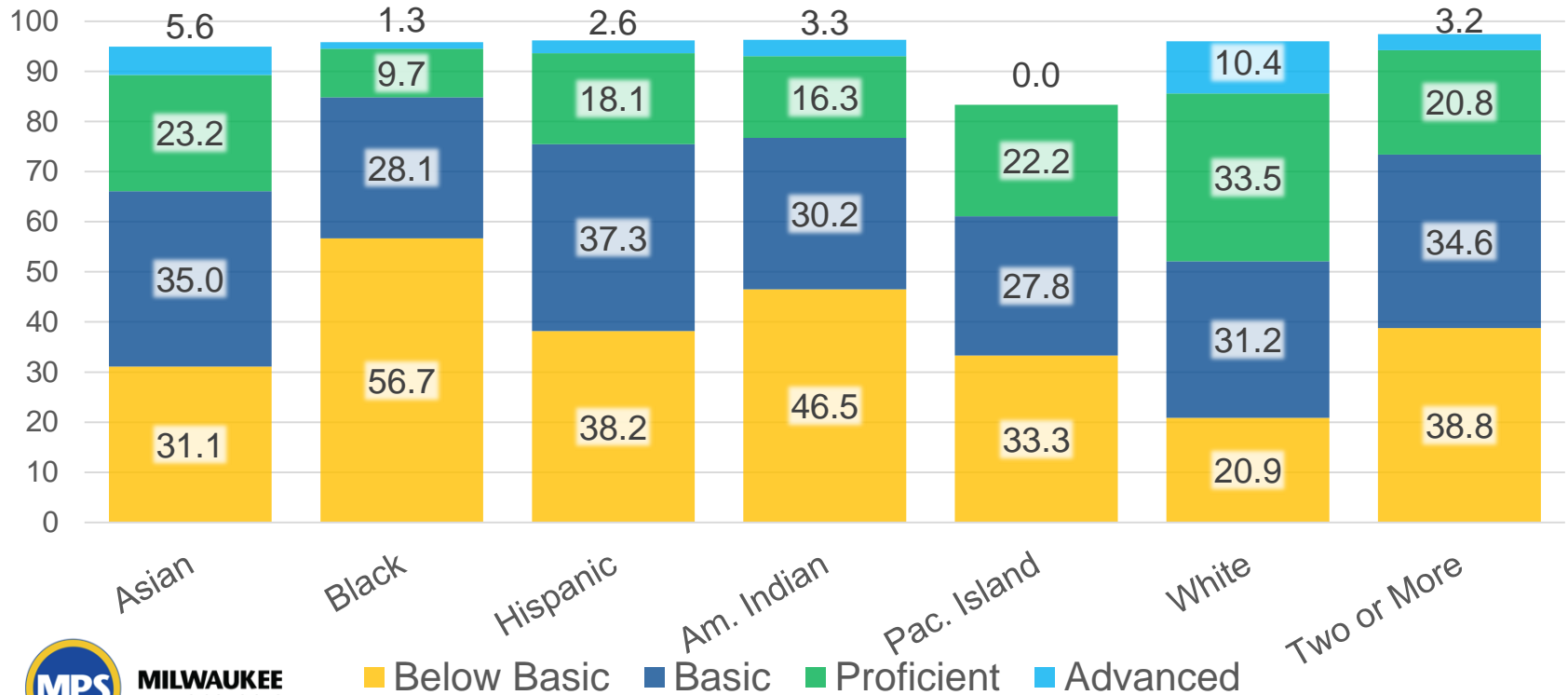
2017 Demographic Breakdowns: ELL Status



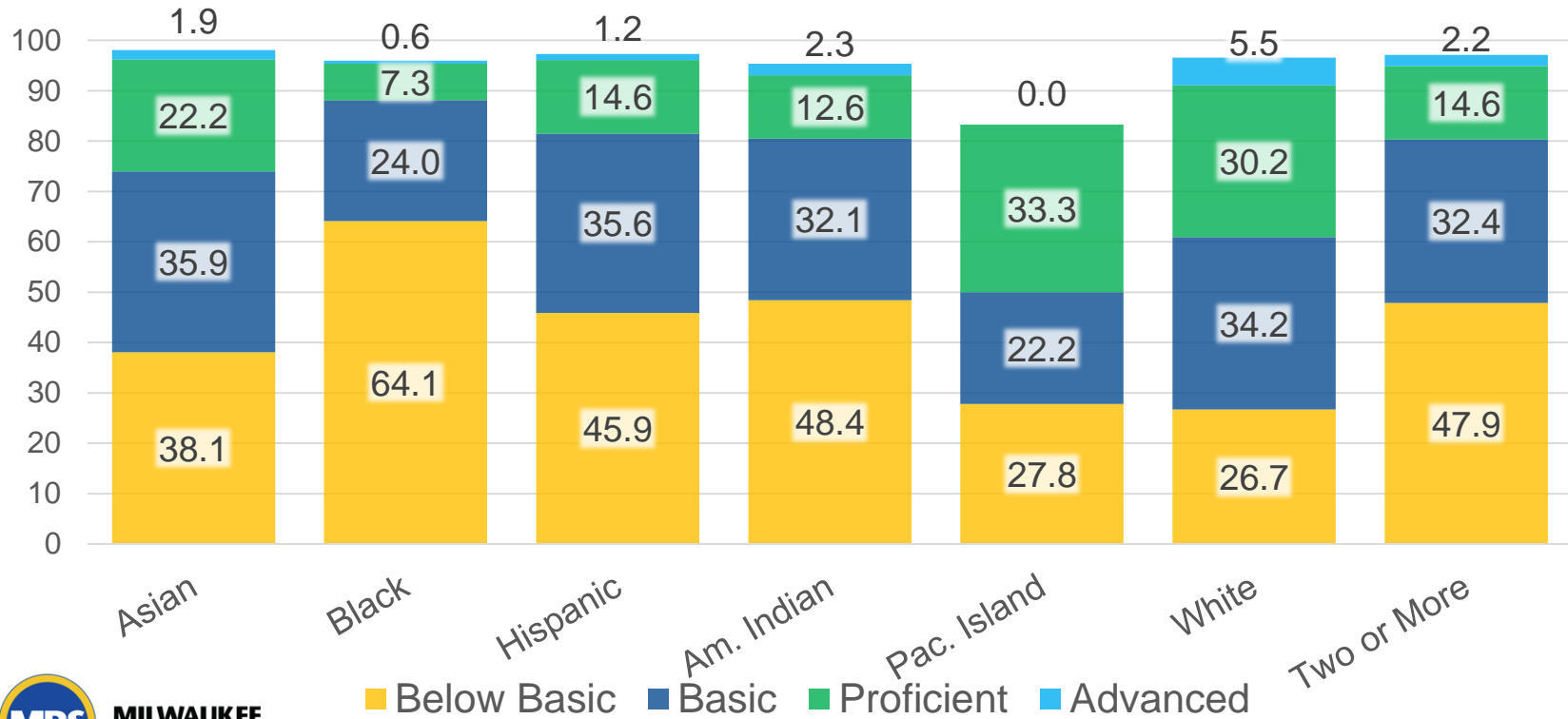
2017 Demographic Breakdowns: Economic Status



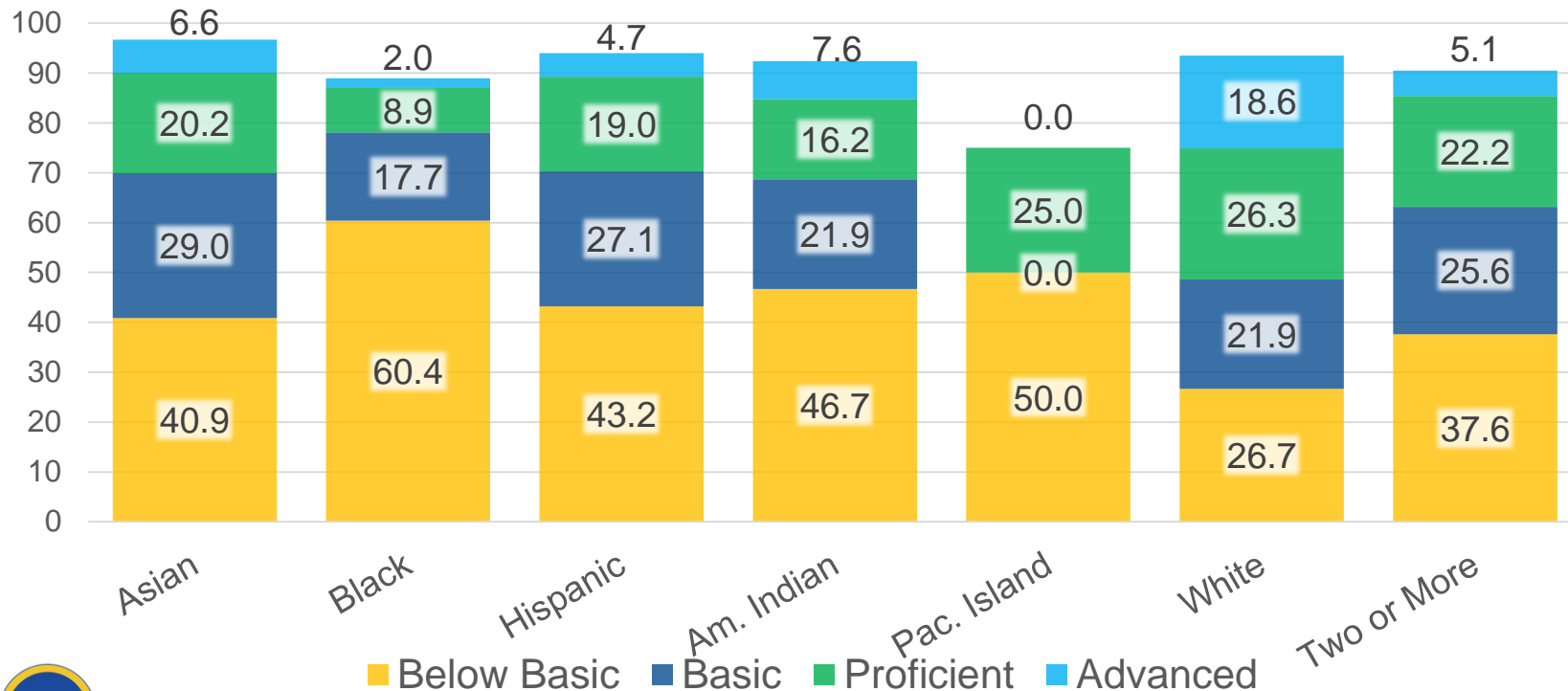
2017 Demographic Breakdowns: ELA by Race



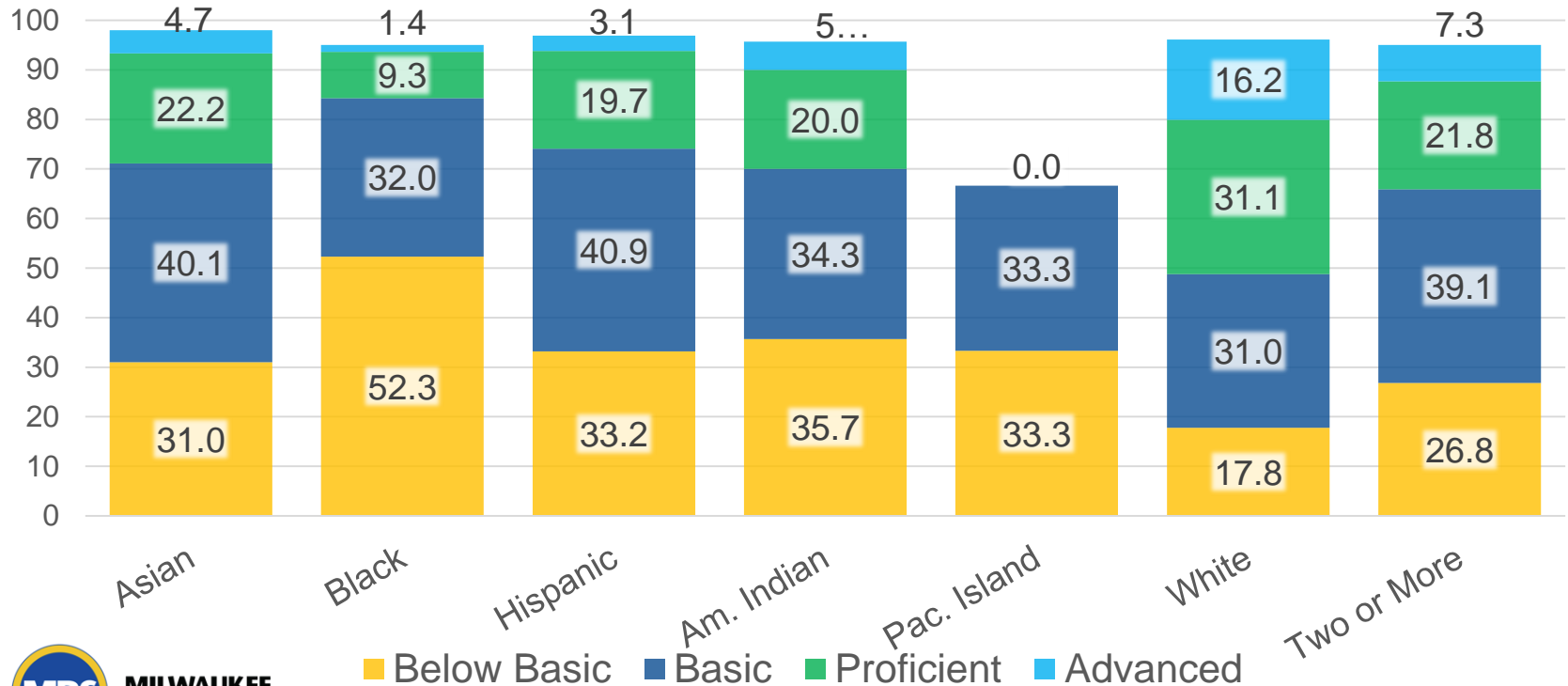
2017 Demographic Breakdowns: Math by Race
