


Professional Development Update

- Almost 50 staff attended the Forward Learning Institute of Financial and Economic Literacy, June 2022
- Over 100 staff members attended the Summer Institute, August 2022
- Average of 29 hours of Next Gen Personal Finance PD for personal finance teachers
 - Increase over last year's 17 hours
 - Ten teachers took over 30 hours
- Every school has at least one teacher trained to teach personal finance
 - Six schools have 2 or more teachers trained
- Eight teachers applied and received scholarships to attend the National JumpStart Conference in November
