Relative to the March 2021 Report of the Committee on Student Achievement and School Innovation, on Resolution 2021R-021 by Director Woodward on an African Immersion School, your Committee recommends:

- 1. That the Board direct the Administration to provide a clear distinction between an African-American Immersion School program and an African Immersion School;
- 2. Over the 2021-22 school year, an audit of the African-American Immersion programing throughout the district be conducted, including program supports;
- 3. That the Andrew Douglas school community be engaged in determining which specialization should be offered at the school;
- 4. That a report be brought back to the board not later than the June 2022 Board cycle.
