This table details the number of incidents for the current month as it compares with that of the same month of the previous school year. For example, in March 2011, there were a total of 30 battery cases, while in March 2012 there were a total of 19 battery cases.

This chart also details the total-to-date number of incidents for the current school year compared with that of the last school year. For example, for the 2010-2011 school year, there were 20 cases of repeated violation of school rules compared to 16 cases for the current school year.
