Such conduct is grounds for expulsion under Wisconsin State Statute 120.13 (1)(c).

Based on these findings, the recommendation of the Senior Director of the Department of Student Services, to expel ••••• is reasonably justified; and the interests of the Milwaukee Public Schools demand that this student be expelled until **May 23, 2023**. Reinstatement into the Milwaukee Public Schools will be through the Department of Student Services.
