Five Priorities for Success



Background


- Remote work pilot program was launched in November 2022.
- Under the pilot, eligible employees in Finance, Human Resources, and Technology were able to work remotely up to three days per week.
- On February 23, 2023, the Board approved a remote work provision for the Employee Handbook.

Remote Work Expansion

- The Employee Handbook allows non-school based employee groups outside of Finance, Human Resources, and Technology to be considered for remote work.
- Review and analysis of non-school based positions conducted by chiefs
 - Over 300 positions were reviewed
 - Developed a remote work position eligibility list
- Updated remote work guidance document(including request form)

Remote Work Website

- Website developed to increase employee accessibility and clarity regarding remote work in the district
- Information provided on the website include:
 - Employee Handbook remote work provision
 - Remote work guidance document
 - Position eligibility list
 - Request form



Additional Remote Work Updates

- Incorporated a remote work statement in job postings for remote work eligible positions
- Developed flyer for employees working remotely
- Working on creating professional development videos regarding remote work with Organizational Development
- Contracting with the Wisconsin Center for Education Research (WCER) to survey employees and supervisors participating in the remote work program
