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Administration Response:

The costs reflected in the funding source table on the first page represent increasing the FTE of three current 0.75 FTE paraprofessional positions so that there can be three 1.0 FTE paraprofessionals at each school.

The following would need to be determined:

- Seniority status of paraprofessional staff
- The number of paraprofessionals that are interested in the increase
- The work that will be assigned to paraprofessionals for the additional hours

Unfilled vacancy and turnover adjustments have already been taken in the budget in the amount of \$20,634,988 to mitigate reductions needed from schools and offices. Historically the budgeted amounts have been close to the actual vacancy and turnover savings and this freeing up of expenses has already been reallocated in the proposed budget. Since the vacancy rate is not available for redistribution, referendum funding would need to be reallocated to support the additional cost of the amendment.

We ask that the Milwaukee Board of School Directors specify which referendum priority and the specific line that should be reduced to fund this amendment.
