Next Steps

- Capacity analysis is the process of modeling the capacity of infrastructure, facilities, processes, services, and systems.
- Capacity is the maximum output of an item based on its design or constraints such as available resources.
 - What capacity does MPS have to do more?
 - What would MPS need to do more of?



Next Steps Continued

- An economic disparity study is a comprehensive effort that analyzes data pertaining to the legal, legislative, and contracting environment facing minority and women business enterprises when procuring contracts from a specific federal, state or municipal agency.
 - What will a disparity study tell us?
 - Will provide government agencies the insight to determine if access to government contracts are unfairly denied to minority and women owned firms in the marketplace.
