




### **Safe Haven Resolution**

- After listening to compelling testimony from students, families and community, on fear of ICE (Immigration and Customs Enforcement) activity in schools the school board unanimously adopted the resolution in April 2017.
- The Safe Haven resolution designates all MPS sites as a Safe Haven for learning and support and outlines steps the district will take to safeguard students and families information Public Schools 4


