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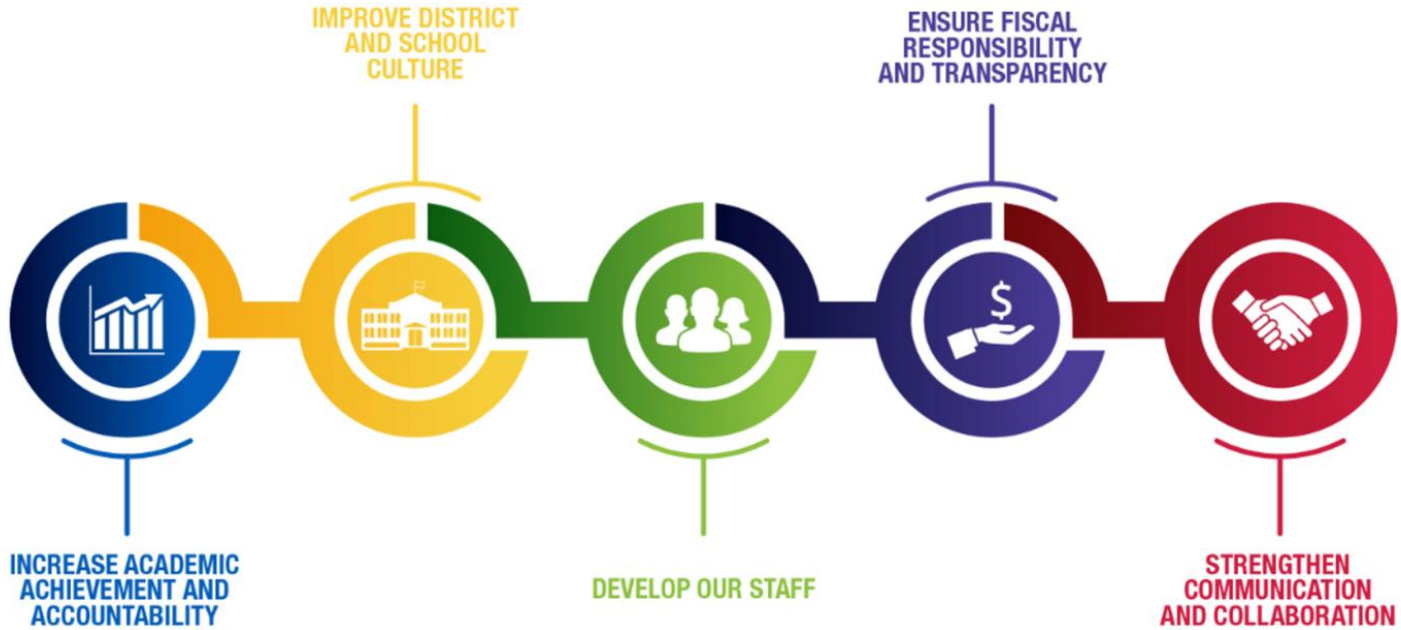

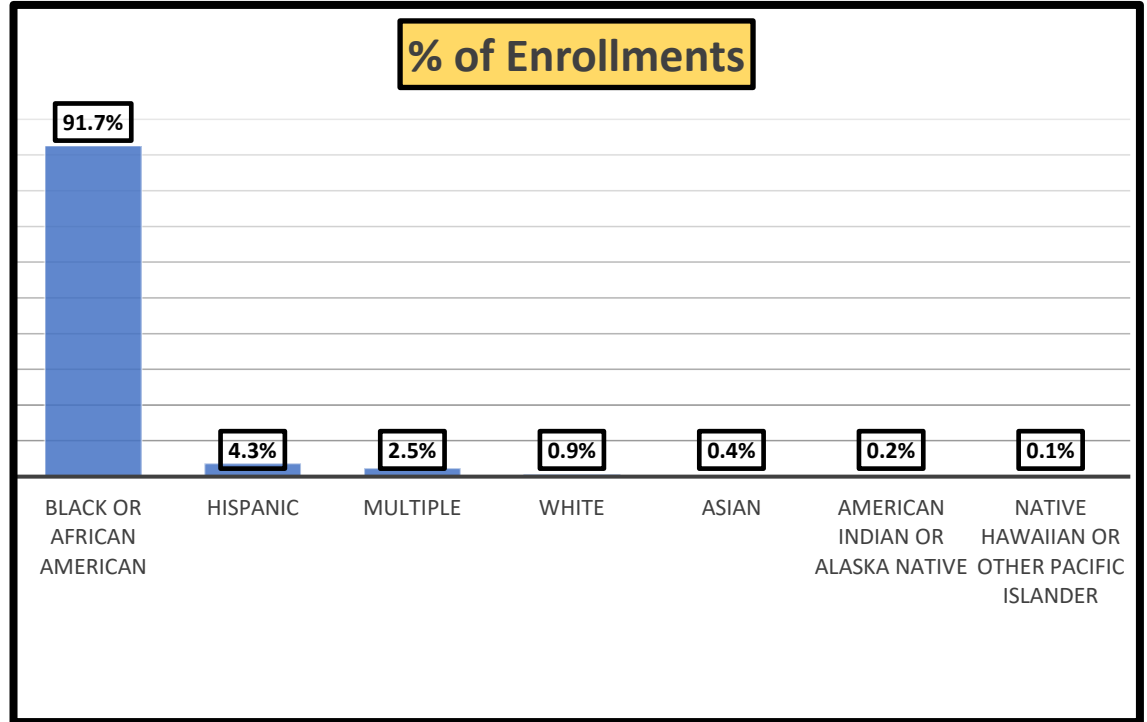

## Mission Statement



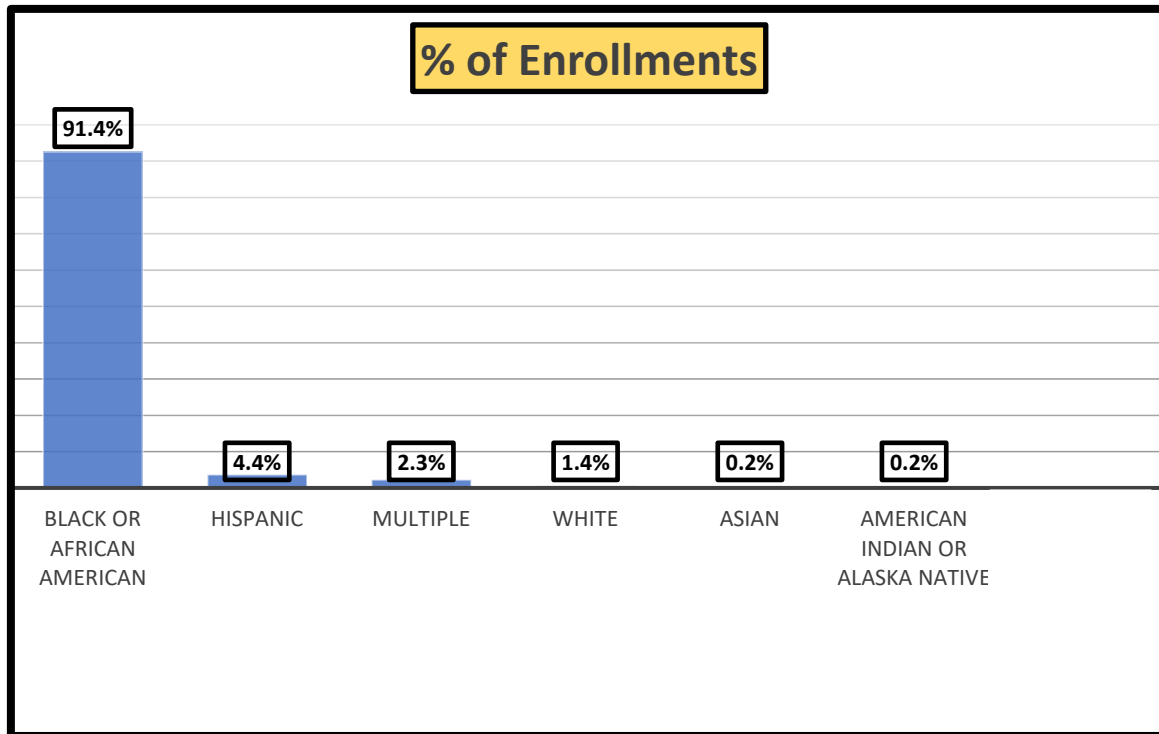
North Division High School is committed to providing academic excellence while instilling morals and values that will create individuality by fostering a passion for learning in students.
