





DPI Performance Levels




PreACT Secure ELA Score – Grade 9 to 10




Grade 9 – 16.3

PreACT Secure Math




PreACT Secure Math Score – Grade 9 to 10




Percent Proficient and Advanced Based on DPI Performance Levels



Exceeding the prepandemic achievement level


