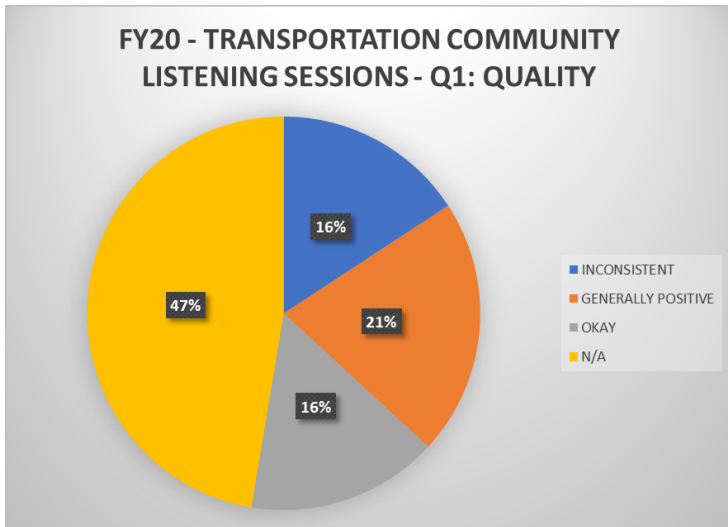


TRANSPORTATION COMMUNITY LISTENING SESSIONS FEEDBACK

1. Quality of current MPS transportation?
 - a. Buses are not 100% on time and there is a concern about teachers staying after, as well as a concern about the need for communication with families when buses are late in the morning. It would be positive if a 3-tier model would provide better service levels.
2. Do you favor modifications to school times if they reduce the transportation budget and improve services?
 - a. Families would generally support if there wasn't a significant time change – i.e. French Immersion moving from 8:30 a.m. to 7:10 a.m.
 - b. There is a concern that if significant changes do occur it would affect enrollment
 - c. Feeder sites should be aligned on a similar bell schedule – i.e. French Immersion and Milwaukee School of Languages
3. What recommendations do you have to reduce costs or improve services (as well as additional feedback)?
 - a. Cutting private school reimbursement (This is currently a State mandate)
 - b. High school students utilizing Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS)
 - c. Reviewing avenues other than transportation to cut
 - d. Reviewing strategic commercial driver's license (CDL) partnerships for driver retainment (amazon, trucking, etc.)
 - e. In house busing, hiring bus drivers as full-time staff
 - f. Do not change bus times significantly as there is a concern that enrollment drops would reduce the district's revenue more than the cost savings for transportation
