Dear School Leaders:

As you know, 42 MPS schools were rated "Fails to Meet Expectations" on the state report card last year, a situation that we all find quite disturbing. We are moving toward a systematic approach for assisting schools to make adequate yearly progress that is needed to transform our most challenging schools. All 42 schools will engage in a quality review process. This letter provides an overview of the School Quality Review (SQR) process. The purpose of the SQR process is to reflect on school performance, engage in dialogue to identify strengths and opportunities, and determine what interventions, if any, are best suited for school turnaround.

The process we will use is based on work that was developed in the Charlotte-Mecklenburg school district. It has been adapted to meet the needs of Milwaukee Public Schools. The Department of Research and Development is leading the development of the work and consulting with district content experts to ensure that it is aligned with the MPS Teaching and Learning Framework. Input on the process has been sought from the regional team and other members of administration. The MTEA has also had an opportunity to review the process and provide feedback.

The School Quality Review process will collect data from a number of sources. Schools will engage in a self-study. Regional teams will engage in a similar school study. A school visit will provide an opportunity for classroom visits and focus group conversations with parents, teachers, students and community partners. Extant data on academics, behavior and staffing will also be part of the data collection process.

The review team will be made up of district staff including regional superintendents, curriculum experts, facilities, human resources and research and development. In addition, a parent and/or community member, as well as an MTEA representative will be part of the team. The principal and school leadership team will have an opportunity to participate as well, engaging with members of the review team at various points throughout the day.

The timeline for completing the work is short. All reports must be ready for the review by the end of March. To complete this work on time, we will conduct the school visits on February 16, 17, 21, 23, 28 and March 2, 7 and 9. We are asking schools to select their walk-through date at the close of the Informational meeting. All due dates are outlined on the calendar that you will receive at the conclusion of the meeting. Please understand that due dates are final in order to maintain the fidelity of the entire process.

We understand that this is a big undertaking. And, we look forward to working collaboratively with you to ensure we reach higher student proficiency for all of our students in every school.
