- National Student Clearinghouse provides data about post-secondary enrollment and graduation from schools and universities

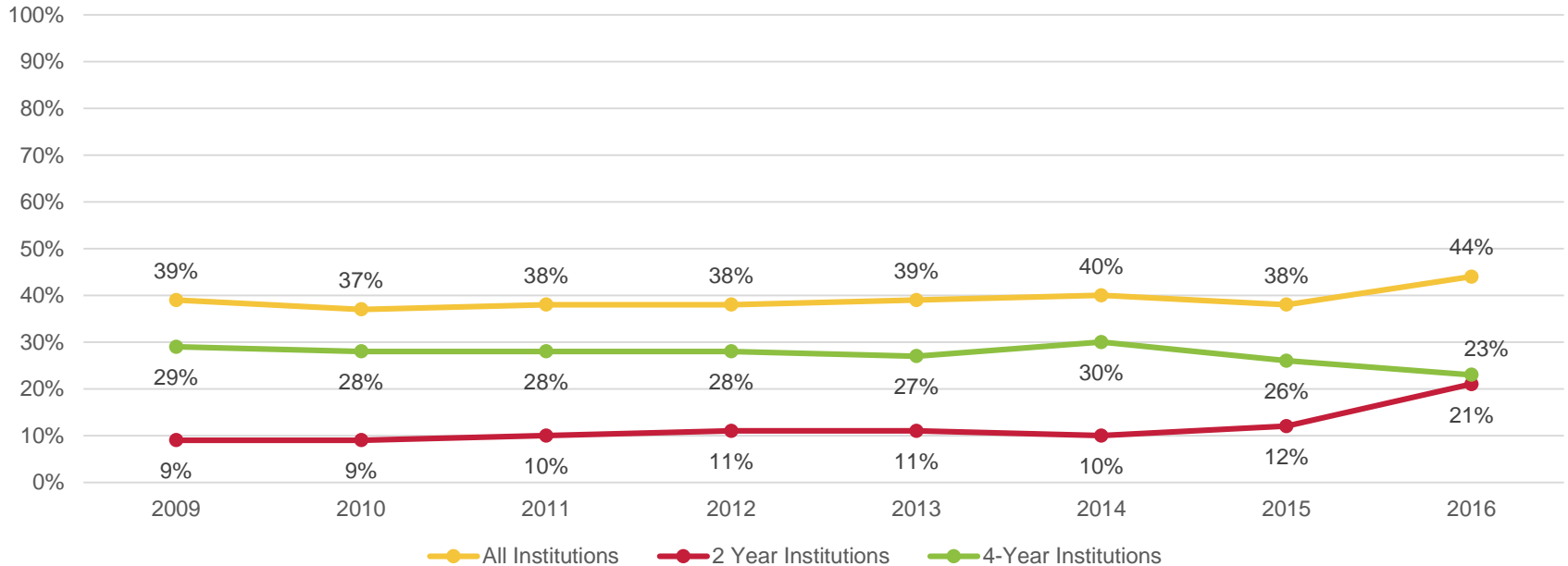


National Student Clearinghouse

- More than 3,600 colleges and universities, enrolling over 98% of all students in public and private U.S. institutions, participate in the Clearinghouse
- Approximately 3.7 million students are tracked by the Clearinghouse nationally

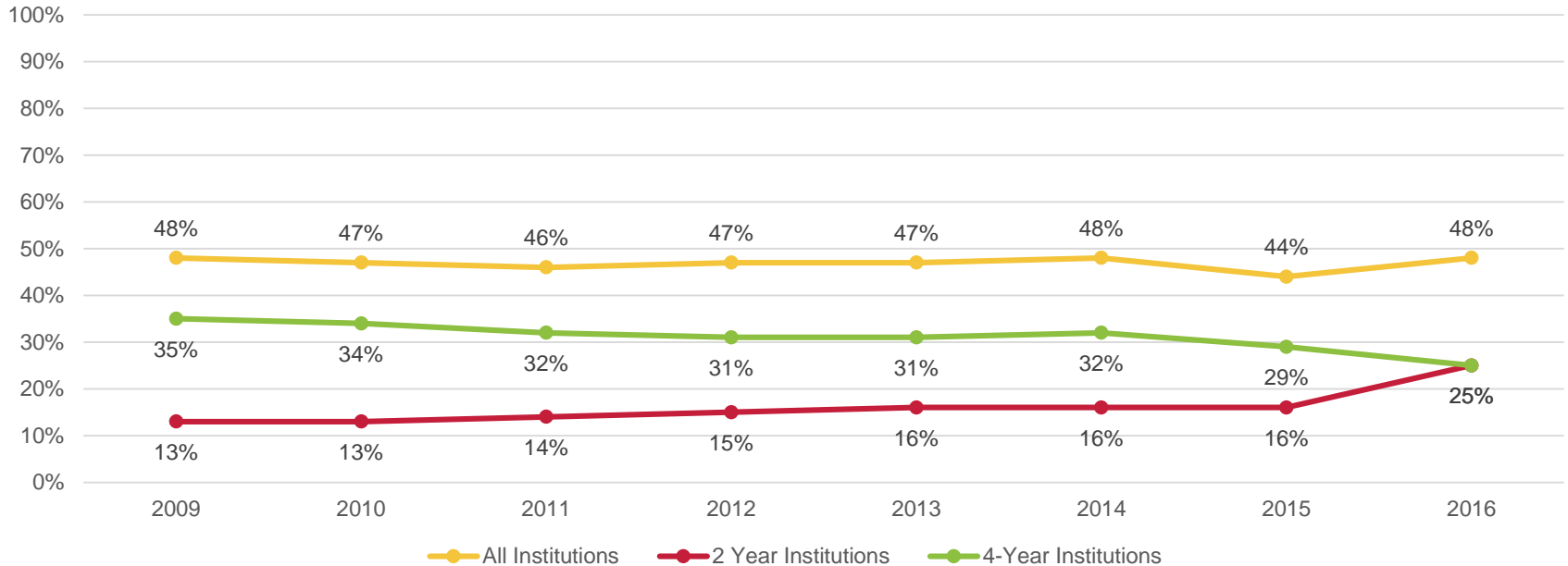
Enrolled the Fall After Graduation

Percent of Students Enrolled in College the Fall Immediately After High School



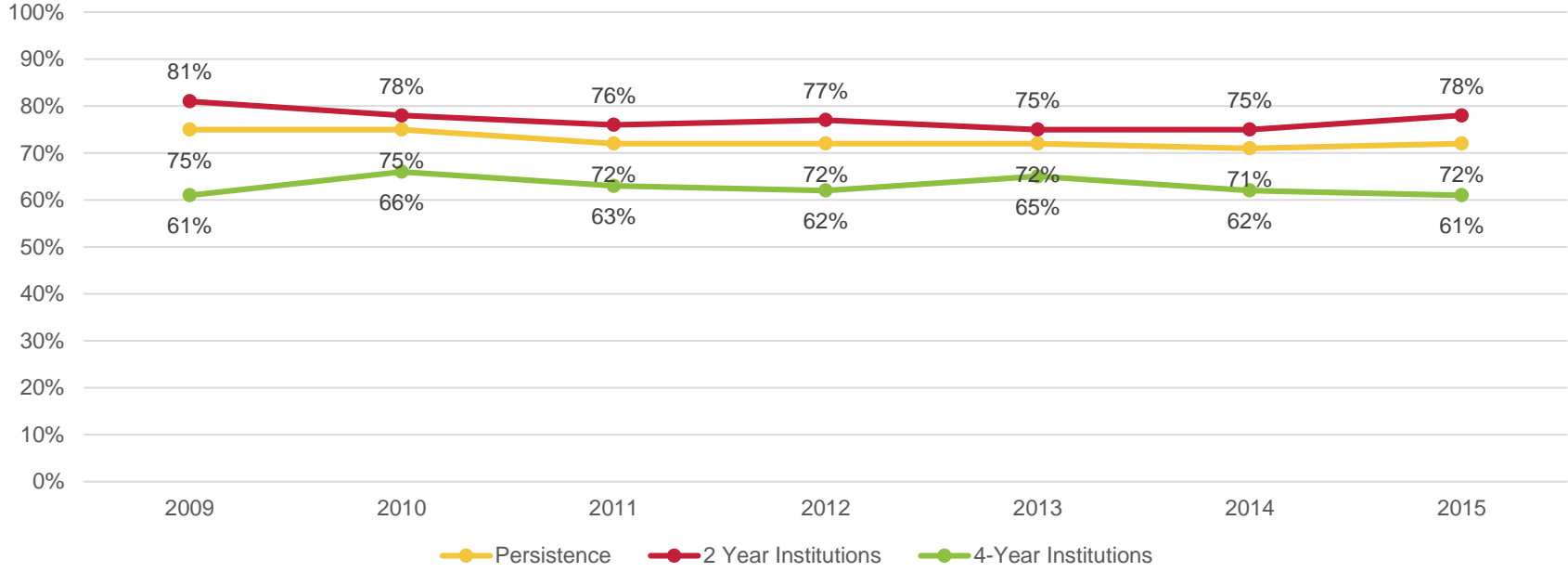
Enroll in First Year After Graduation

Percent of Students Enrolled in College During the First Year After High School



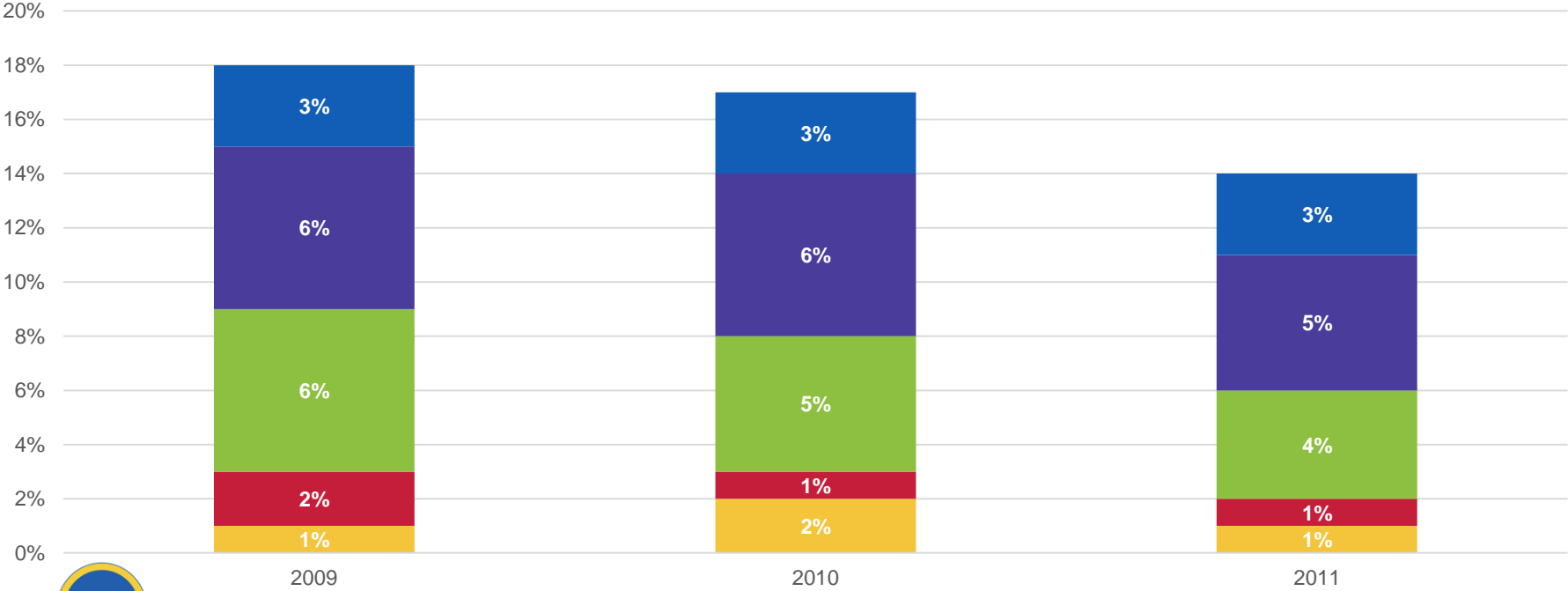
Persistence

Persistence of Students that Returned for a Second Year



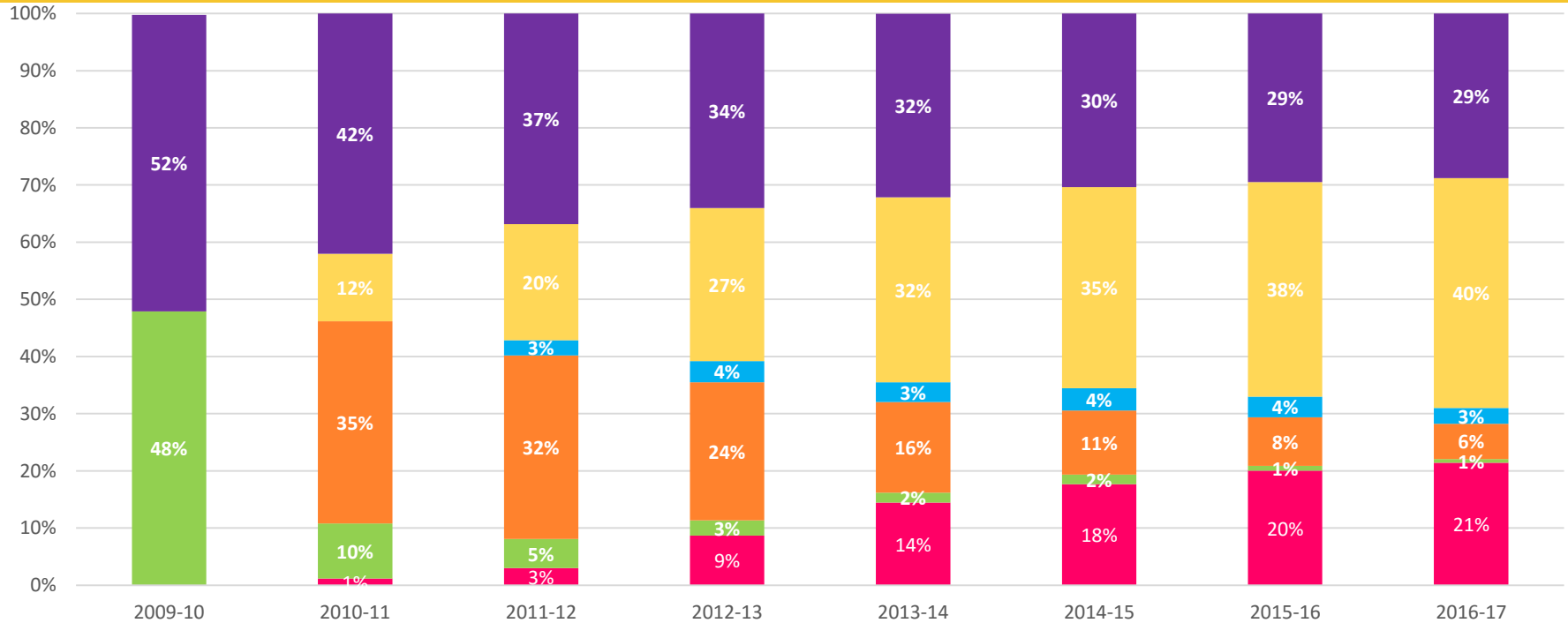
Time to Graduation

Time to College Graduation Within 6 Years



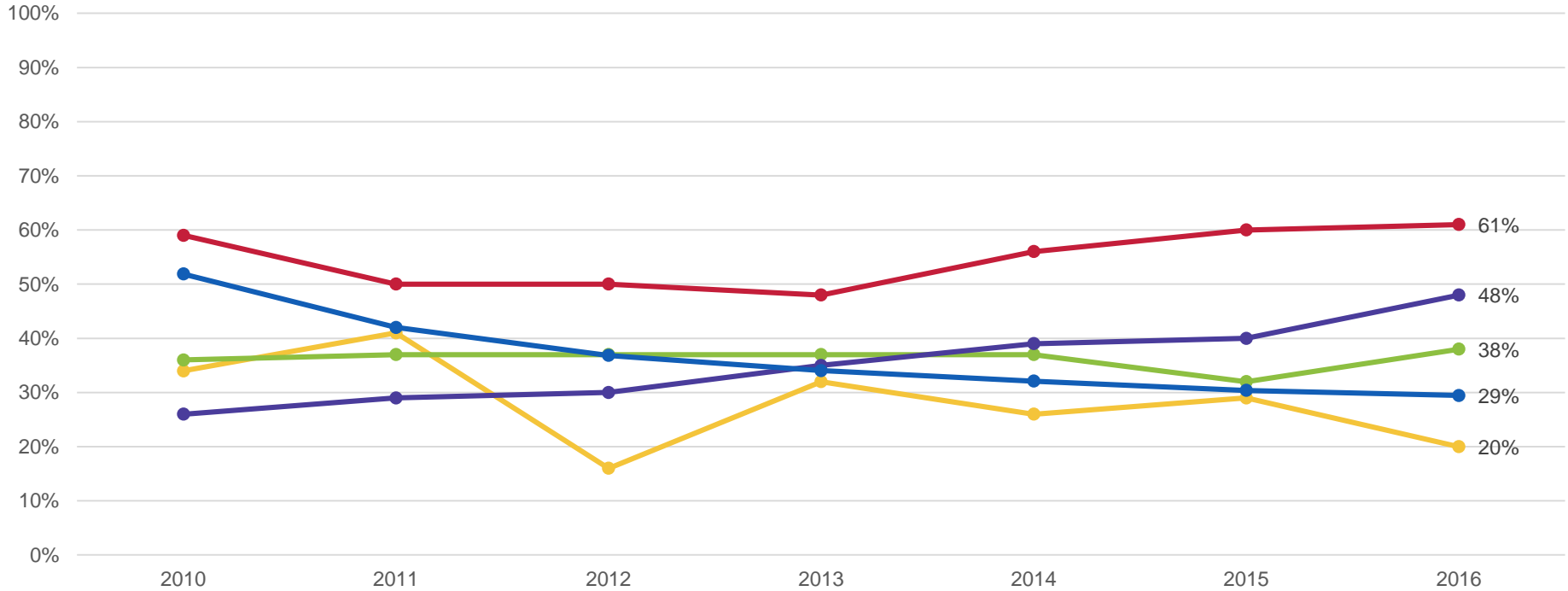

Class of 2009 Enrollment & Progress

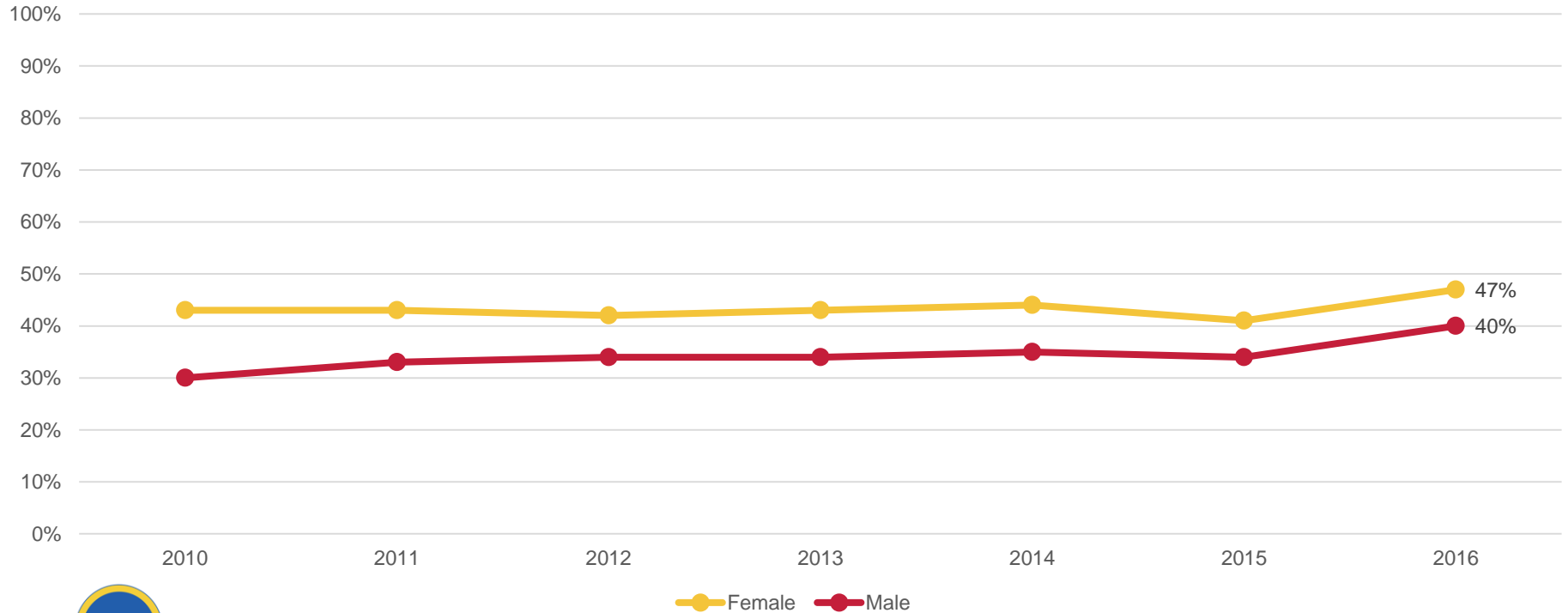

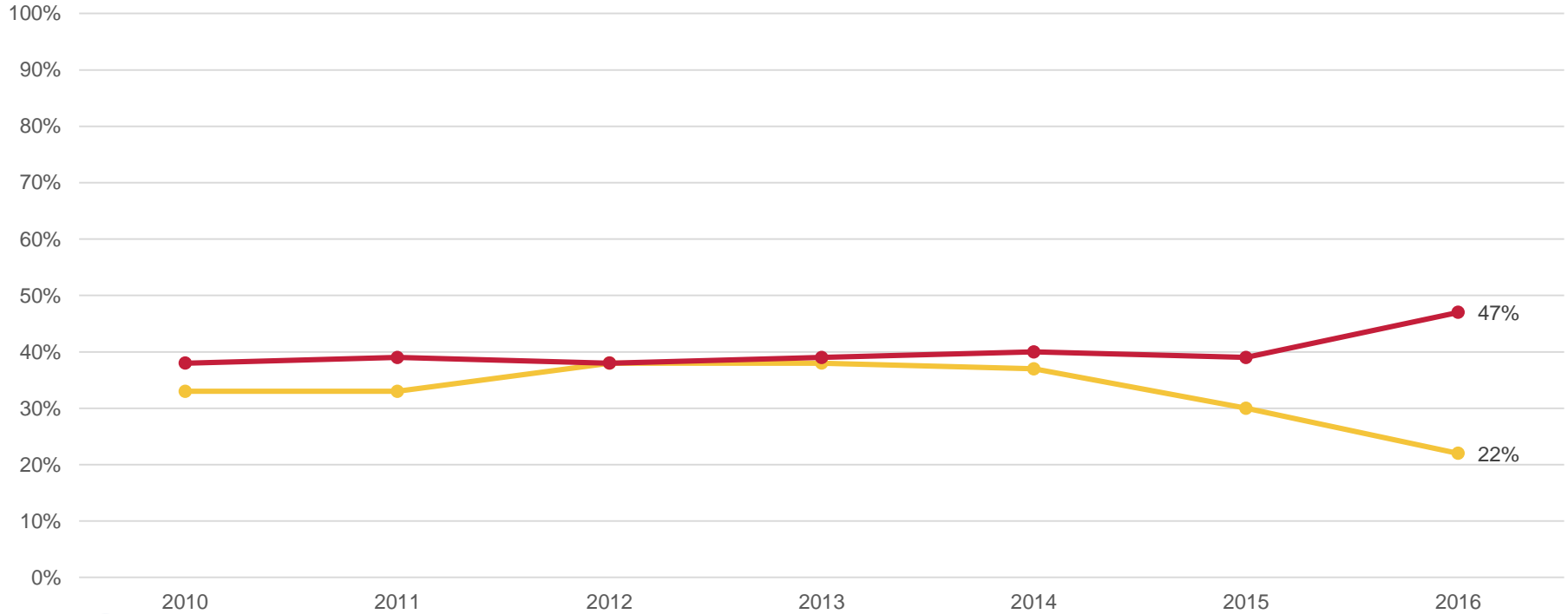
Enrollment First Fall by Ethnicity
