- The districts have a range of \$100.00 \$120.00 for the daily rate for substitute teachers.
- Long-term rates (15 20 consecutive days) for substitutes also vary, from \$120.00 to \$200.00.
- Many districts have a higher per diem for retired substitute teachers (Waukesha, Wauwatosa and West Bend).

Benefits:

- Wauwatosa offers benefits to select subs, it is an alternative health plan with high deductibles.
- No other districts offer health, dental, vision and life insurance benefits.

Substitute Pay:

- Some districts offer substitute positions to pre-bachelor's degree candidates (Austin and Baltimore) and the positions pay \$52.00 and \$75.00 per day respectively
- Pay rates for daily subs have a range of \$52.00 \$150.00 per day.
- Long-term rates have a range of \$100.00 \$224.00 per day
- Philadelphia pays the most, with a long-term rate of \$224.00 per day, but that rate goes ONLY to retired teachers from the Philadelphia School District. Philadelphia has outsourced the entire substitute process to Kelly Educational Services.
- It is difficult to compare pay rates without having an understanding of the differences in the cost of living.

Benefits:

- Detroit offers benefits only to the highest level of substitute. The sub must be assigned to a leave of absence by Human Resources, they are contracted annually. If they fail to complete the agreement, they go back to a daily sub and they relinquish benefits.
- Cleveland offers benefits to full-time subs (must work full-time, every day for 10-months). After completion of 10-months they are benefits eligible, but only while they continue to work full-time.
- Philadelphia offers substitutes and ADA compliant health care plan through Kelly Educational Services (Staffing Service).
