Intent (required):

To support the expansion of art offerings by designating additional professional development to support new and growing visual arts educators. Allocating specialist(s) to mentor new visual art educators would provide sustainability to quality visual arts education within the district beyond supplemental funding. This amendment does not decrease funding allocated for additional teachers, however, it specifically designates 2 of the additional teachers (FTEs) as specialists to mentor new visual arts teachers

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Administration Response:

The administration agrees that to effectively support arts educators, mentor teachers are needed. Currently, there is one centralized visual arts support teacher in the budget. The proposed amendment would create two more positions by reducing newly funded phase II art positions in the referendum. Phase II funds have already been allocated and many of the new positions have been filled in the hiring process.

The administration recommends adding one position since one already exists. Instead of redirecting one of the phase II art teacher positions the administration proposes reducing the ESSER II Budget Detail page 9 to fund the second visual arts support teacher. Therefore, the allocation on page 9 would be reduced by \$101,358 and the funding would be used instead to add an additional 1 FTE centralized visual arts support teacher (salary and benefits).
