

REPORT OF THE BOARD'S DELEGATE TO CESA #1

The Board of Control of CESA #1 met on December 18, 2018.

The Board approved the 2017-18 audit, copies of which Board members had received last month.

The cost of health insurance for the 2019-20 school year looks good. No major increases are seen.

Several board members attended the Association of Educational Service Agencies on November. 28 through December 1 in Colorado Springs. All attending members felt that Wisconsin was well represented and that our state is ahead of many, with our CESAs providing excellent services.

The Institute for Personalized Learning continues to move ahead. More than 60 people attended our most recent field experience on December 3 and 4. Individuals came from Wisconsin, Illinois, Arkansas, Iowa, and Missouri. The next field experience will be on February 12 and 13. The 9th Annual National Convening on Personalized Learning had more than 400 attendees from 13 states.

Terry Falk will be CESA #1's delegate to the WASB Delegate Assembly to be held at the WASB annual convention in January. Board members were given copies of proposed resolutions to be voted on at the assembly.

Project SEARCH is a program of CESA #1 for students with special needs. These students are getting job training and experiences which are often leading to full-time jobs after their public school education. Several job experiences were outlined.

ESSA has replaced No Child Left Behind; however, new rules mean new ways of doing things and of reporting. School districts must make adjustments. To that end, CESA #1 is offering a series of workshops in these areas:

- Friday, February. 22 Part 2: Data Inquiry Process — Data Team Readiness and Data Source Audit
- Friday, March 22 Part 3: Data Inquiry Process — Root Cause Analysis and Theory of Action
- Monday, May 13 Part 4: Practices Inquiry for Continuous Improvement Planning

Other CESA #1 programs and workshops previously highlighted continue.
