

Menu Improvements

- Department of Nutrition Services is collaboratively working with student groups like YES Group and Milwaukee Community Schools Partnership to continuously improve the food quality
- More food choices, including a hot vegetarian entrée option, are offered daily at both elementary and high schools during the 2023-24 school year
- Only hot food items are being pre-packed and cold food items are being directly delivered to sites allowing students to choose what they want to eat

Production Kitchens

- Number of MPS production kitchens:
 - Production kitchens at the end of 2021-22 school year totaled 21
 - Production kitchens at the end of 2022-23 school year totaled 31
 - Currently, there are 42 production kitchens
 - 15 additional schools are currently being considered to become production kitchens

Equipment and Staffing

- MPS has signed a contract with a vendor to replace approximately 350 pieces of equipment. Work has begun and is expected to be completed before the start of 2024-25 school year
- Number of vacancies as of January 31, 2024 is 122
 - Managers 20
 - Assistants 102
