Reinstatement into the Milwaukee Public Schools will be through the Department of Student Services.

The Officer also directs the Administration to provide the following services during the expulsion period.

- MPS Partnership School Placement.
- Social Work Referral.
- Online Academic Support.

Within 30 days of this expulsion order the Milwaukee Board of School Directors will review the expulsion order and shall upon review approve, reverse, or modify the order. The order of the Hearing Officer shall be enforced while the Board of School Directors reviews the order. You will be notified in writing of the Board of School Directors' decision. The decision of the Board of School Directors may be appealed to the State Superintendent of Schools. A copy of the Wisconsin law regarding the expulsion of students which describes the steps you may take if you wish to appeal the decision of the Board of School Directors is attached.
