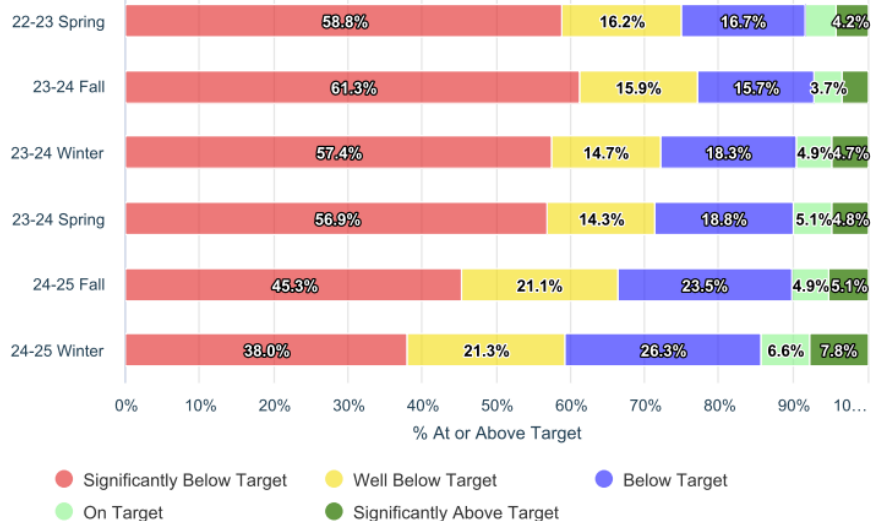


Central Region Climate Data

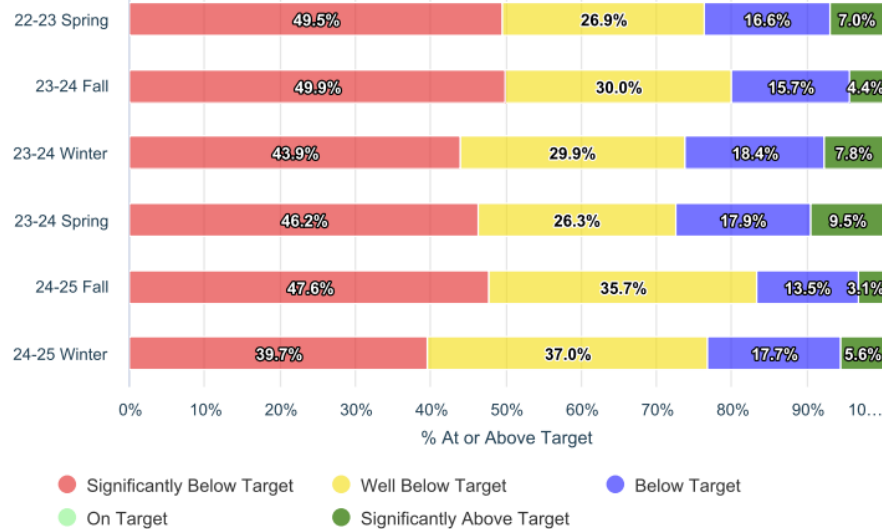

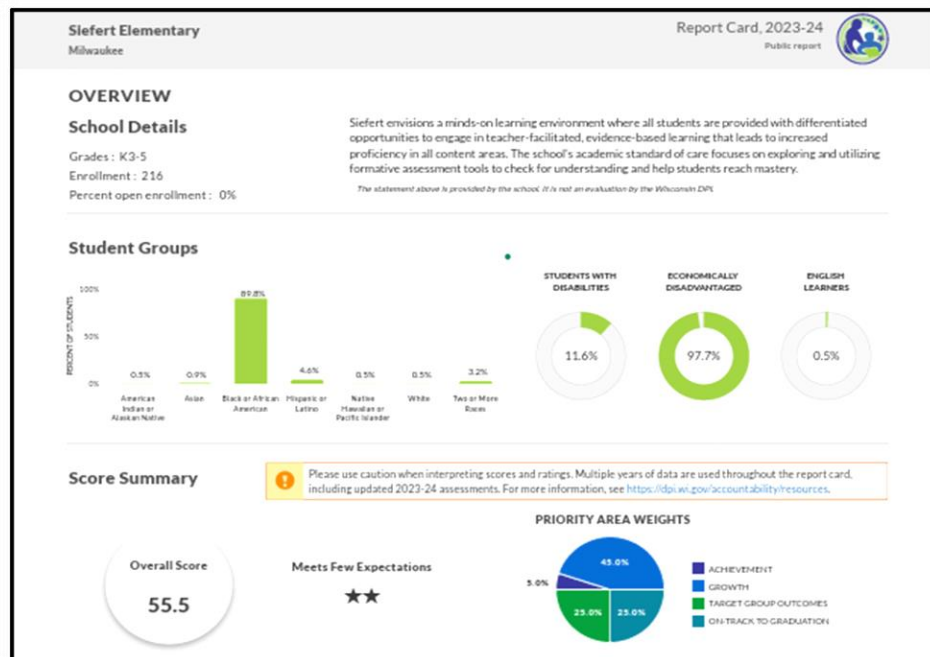
Siefert Points of Pride
