The Administration recommends that the Board approve the following exception-to-bid contracts:

Exception Authorization to Contract with STEM Happens Network, Inc. for STEM Teacher Professional Development

The Administration is requesting authorization to enter into a contract with STEM Happens Network, Inc. (SHN) to assist in developing, executing, and supporting a comprehensive STEM plan to move current disciplinary STEM practices to an interdisciplinary approach and eventual shift to "trans-disciplinary" in identified pilot GE STEM Schools. Additionally, SHN will assist in the development of a professional learning community that facilitates the exploration of interdisciplinary approaches and exemplary student-led projects through the integration of Science, Math, Technology and Engineering practices in schools using project-based inquiry science. The use of SHN is required by the associated grant.

This contract will launch the first phase of the pilot GE STEM School work in eleven identified schools: Curtin Leadership Academy; I.D.E.A.L; Whitman School; Victory School; Lincoln Center of the Arts; Morse Middle School; King IB Middle School; Webster Secondary School; Wedgewood Park School; Roosevelt Middle School; and Audubon Technology and Communication Middle School.

The contract will run from April 1, 2018 through September 30, 2018. The total cost of the contract will not exceed \$75,000.
