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## MOVING SERVICES - VARIOUS PROJECTS AND SITES <br> RFP \#18004

## 1. Description of Project and Proposed Vendor

A Request for Proposal (RFP) was issued by Facilities and Maintenance Services to obtain firms to provide the moving services associated with relocations, program changes and remodeling on an as-needed basis. The contract period is for three (3) years although there is no guarantee of any work. A total of six (6) firms' submitted responses. The firms with the highest rankings per the evaluation criteria for the services requested are as follows:

- C. Coakley Relocation Systems
- Coakley Brothers
- Perfect Install, Inc.


## 2. Justification for Selection of Proposed Vendor

The firms were evaluated for all criteria provided and the order of use will be based upon the firm's qualifications based on the type and size of each moves' requirements, cost, vendor performance and availability. Due to the nature of the contract and capacity of qualified firms, the HUB requirement for this contract is $25 \%, 100$ Hours of Student Paid Employment \& 10 hours of Career Education per 12-month contract.

## 3. RFP Evaluation Criteria

$20 \%$ Overall cost of the Moving Services
$20 \%$ The experience and qualifications of the team in providing management of similar size projects.
$20 \%$ The experience and qualifications of specific personnel included as a part of the team, including past performance with MPS.
20\% Project approach, including proposed control of Costs and Schedules for moves, as well as team training, testing and equipment support.
20\% Reference responses, including past performance with MPS.
Pass/Fail Respondent meets the minimum amount of Contract Compliance Services Requirements established within this RFP.

## 4. Experience in Other Districts/MPS

All three firms have provided substantial moving services to MPS in the past.

- C. Coakley Relocation Systems has also provided services for UW-Madison, Racine Unified School District and Indian Community School.
- Coakley Brothers has also provided services for Marquette University, Racine Unified School District, and UWMilwaukee.
- Perfect Installs, Inc. has provided services for Alverno College, Joy Global of Milwaukee and Children's Hospital and Health System, Milwaukee


## 5. Evaluation Plan

The services will be requested on an as-needed basis by Facilities and Maintenance who will also be responsible for providing evaluations of the firm's ability to perform the requested services as detailed in the RFP. Failure to provide an acceptable level of service or billings that are not in accordance with the fees submitted will be cause for termination of contract.
6. Cost

Fees were requested on a number of personnel positions, equipment rental, storage and supplies - an overview of the fees for each firm is provided. The annual not to exceed amount will be divided between the three vendors as needed.
