After hearing testimony and taking evidence, the Officer appointed by the Board of School Directors finds as follows:

By Endangerment of Physical Safety/Mental Well-being at Assata High School on Thursday, November 21, 2019, ••••• engaged in conduct while at school and while under the supervision of a school authority, which endangered the property, health and safety of others while at school and under the supervision of a school authority. Such conduct is grounds for expulsion under Wisconsin State Statute 120.13 (1)(c).

Based on these findings, the recommendation of the Senior Director of the Department of Student Services, to expel ••••• is reasonably justified; and the interests of the Milwaukee Public Schools demand that this student be

expelled until December 22, 2020 . Reinstatement into the Milwaukee Public Schools will be through the Department of Student Services.
