


## **Background and Goals**

- Board action 2017 to address concerns related to the state report card scores
- Created only for students enrolled at South and Vincent
- Maximum of 100 students in each academy
- Students with credit deficiency and/or low attendance
- 2019 update to the Board led to use of the Competency curriculum at both sites


## **Enrollment Data**

#### Number of Students Enrolled




## **Attendance Data**






## **Dropout Data**

#### Recommendations

Based on the data and the need for teachers, the recommendation is to close both Accelerated Academies at the Third Friday reassignment date of the 2024-2025 school year.

- Meeting with the Accelerated Academy students
- Sending a letter to families regarding closure
- Enrolling all of the current Accelerated Academy students in the Competency program existing at their current school building
