ADMINISTRATIVE POLICIES OF THE MILWAUKEE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Administrative Policy 7.10 DRIVER EDUCATION

(1) The Milwaukee Public Schools shall provide a state-approved driver-_education course which shall qualify students 16 years of age and older to receive a Wisconsin probationary operator's license. Instruction shall State-approved driver education courses require a minimum of 30 hours of classroom instruction, six hours in a car as an "observer," and six hours of behind-the-wheel training, and six hours of behind-the-wheel observation.

(2) Driver education shall take place outside of the school day and shall be available during the school year and in summer when funds are available. Students must be at least $\frac{151}{15}$ years old to be enrolled and cannot turn 18 prior to the last day of classroom instruction.

(3) Age-eligible students who are residents of Milwaukee may enroll in driver-_education classes or instruction by following the registration procedures listed in the quarterly Recreation Guide published by through the Department of Recreation and Community Services.
