School-to-Work Transition Program







- Provides high school students with special education needs real-life, vocational instruction in communitybased worksites:
 - Community Assessment and Training Program

Youth Apprenticeships

- A youth apprenticeship is a one- or two-year structured, work-based learning opportunity for high school juniors and seniors. Students pair on-the-job training and related classroom instruction in one of the 83 occupational pathways.

MPS as an Employer – DFMS

- Since 2007, the Department of Facilities and Maintenance Services (DFMS) has supported the youth apprenticeship program and has 33 students currently participating in the trades.
