## **Initial Survey Results**

- Students: 20,619 69.8% of students in grades 6-12
- Staff: 4,840 56.3% based on 8,593 FTE

Community (identified): 3,110 – 155.5% of our 2,000 goal


Families (identified): 4,781 59.7% of our 8,000 goal




78.9% the total 10,000 goal

#### Gender?




#### Are you Hispanic/Latino(a)?

## **Understanding Results**

Single Response:

- These are items participants are allowed only one choice
- Percentages will add up to ~100% (rounding may result in a score of 99-101%)
- The larger the percentage the more predominant the response

Multiple Select Items:


 Individual response percentages tend to be smaller if there are a wide range of responses/beliefs


If response percentages are high on a few items, these responses were chosen by most participants



The top 3 words that describe families' experience interacting with their school:


- Respect

This was the same in all grade bands.

In all grade bands, parents felt their child knew what to do in an emergency and parents knew how an emergency would be communicated.

The majority of parents believe they have opportunity to provide feedback and share ideas regarding the school community and continuous improvement planning. The "neither agree or disagree" group gets larger as the students get older.




### How often do you participate in school-related events?




# What would make it easier/more likely for you to participate/attend school-related activities?




### What methods of communication do you prefer most?



## Would you support changing all schools to one calendar?






### What role do community organizations play in supporting students?




# With the mission statement in mind, what skills do students need to be successful in higher education, post-education opportunities, work, and/or citizenship?




### How do you perceive MPS?






# Which of the following support services are you aware of that are available to community members?




# How much do you agree with the following statement: MPS should merge small, low-enrolled schools to assist with staffing schools appropriately?






# Which of the following areas does MPS as a whole need to improve?
