

The Milwaukee Army Recruiting Battalion Commander, Lieutenant Colonel Collin Keenan, and the Milwaukee Company Commander, Captain Neil Plummer, request the opportunity to come before the board in order to:

1. Introduce ourselves and the Recruiters we represent to the board, the educators and the parents of MPS 2. Familiarize the board, educators and parents with the most numerous educational benefits, programs and opportunities the Army affords, and the various ways we are able to help support the MPS 3. Propose an Army-led Joint Military Educational/Career Fair (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard) for the entire MPS junior and senior high school student population in the April-May timeframe of 2020 4. Request creation of the "School List" we receive each year (i.e. the contact information for military aged high school students whose parents have not opted out) that divides the students by high school, instead of a single alphabetical list that we historically receive that is very difficult for our Recruiters to effectively utilize. In my reading of the MPS Administrative Policy 8.42, I did not discover a clause that would preclude the division of the School List by individual high schools. Hopefully the board would agree with me in this interpretation, or if there is a clause I have missed or I am otherwise in error, then I would humbly request an amendment to the MPS Administrative Policy, as I do not believe an arrangement of the names by high schools would untowardly affect the privacy of any of the students or their families.

The pertinent citation from MPS Administrative Policy version 8.42 follows:

1. "The District shall provide, on a request made by military recruiters or institutions of higher education, access to secondary-school pupils' names, addresses and telephone listings."
2. "A secondary-school pupil, or the parent/guardian of a pupil, has until November 1 to request that the pupil's name, address, and/or telephone listing not be released to military recruiters or institutions of higher education without prior written parental consent."

Lt. Col. Keenan and myself would of course be available for general questions by the board and audience. Our overall intent would be to either elicit eventual votes to support our proposals, to lay the groundwork for future board votes to support our proposals, or to evoke the assistance of the MPS administration in bringing our various proposals to fruition.

If you request any information from me to help facilitate this board agenda proposal, I am at your service.

As we discussed, the soonest MPS Board Meeting would be ideal, but as the School List is not released until November, if we must wait a time for an opportunity to come before the board, then we will standby for the soonest possible opportunity. Please let me know what the results of the decision are to include us in the agenda of a board meeting, - and which meeting that might be, so I can confirm that I can confirm we will be available that day.

I have attached one of my digital recruiting posters to this email as a way of further introduction of myself, and in case you wish to share it with anyone for a better window into what I and my fellow Army Recruiters here in Milwaukee are about.
