# Facilities

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Additional air purifiers</li> <li>• Additional air filters for air purifiers</li> <li>• Fans</li> </ul>
<b>Bottle Filling Station Installation Menu of Services</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Additional installation of water stations per building (schools will be receiving water stations per ESSER III funds)</li> </ul>
<b>Interior Finishes Menu of Services</b>
Furniture to include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cafeteria tables</li> <li>• Classroom furniture</li> <li>• Corridor furniture</li> <li>• Outdoor furniture</li> <li>• Alternative seating furniture</li> </ul>
<b>Building Modifications/Additions Menu of Services</b>

Desktop Computer - Lenovo M70s  Lenovo 22in monitor	PC, keyboard and mouse only.  Purchase monitor if needed. To replace older model desktops in schools.  <b>District will be purchasing these devices for all schools. Wait until after district delivery to order more.</b>
Laptop Computer - Lenovo L15	Laptop to be secured to Interactive Flat Panel. Replaces older model laptops.  <b>District will be purchasing these devices for all schools. Wait until after district delivery to order more.</b>

<p>USB-C Power Adapters - AG-45W- USBC04</p>	<p>USB-C power adapters are the standard for all new Chromebook. The Chromebook using barrel adapters end of life is 6/1/2022.
