Wisconsin Forward Exam

- Students performance in relation to the Wisconsin Academic Standards
- English language arts and math in 3rd grade through 8th grade
- Science will be given in 4th and 8th grade
- Social Studies will be given in 4th 8th and 10th grade





Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM™)

- The DLM[™] assessment measures the academic progress of students with the most significant cognitive disabilities
 - English language arts and math at 3rd through 11th grade
 - Science at 4th and 8th through 11th grades
 - Social Studies at 4th, 8th, and 10th grades





- The ACT® with writing includes reading, math, English, science, and writing at 11th grade
- The ACT with writing is a paper and pencil test
- Wisconsin high schools will be certified as ACT® state testing sites. Scores from the administration of the ACT with writing can be used for college admission, scholarships, course placement, and NCAA eligibility






 There have been improved scores in Math, Science and Social Studies on the WI Forward Exam since 2016!

 Golda Meir School, Milwaukee German Immersion School, Cooper School and Whittier School outperformed the state average in English Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies tests




English Language Arts Grades 3-8

19.6% proficient and above













Mathematics Grades 3-8

16.1% proficient and above













Science Grades 4 and 8

21.8% proficient and above






Wisconsin Forward and DLM™ Science






Social Studies Grades 4, 8 and 10

Wisconsin Forward and DLM™ Social Studies






ACT® and DLM™

- The percentage of not economically disadvantaged students that are proficient or above has increased over the last three years in English Language Arts and Math on the ACT
- These same students improved in science in the spring of 2018
- Three high schools, Carmen South, King International Baccalaureate, and Ronald Reagan, exceeded the state average on the English Language Arts portion of the ACT
- Ronald Reagan exceeded the state average on the ACT Math test




ACT® and **DLM™** ELA






ACT® and **DLM™** Math
