## AP, IB, and Dual Enrollment


- Advanced Placement: Develop college skills. time management, critical thinking, scholarly writing—
   AP courses and exams help hone the skills needed for college and career. Grades 9-12
- International Baccalaureate: Two-year educational program primarily aimed at students in grades 11 and 12. The program provides an internationally accepted qualification for entry into higher education and is recognized by many universities worldwide.

  - Early College Credit Program/Start College Now









#### **AP & IB Exam Outcomes**
