INTRAMURAL YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAMS

The Board believes that school-based sports constitute a part of the total school program educational experience. Accordingly, an intramural youth sports program, as an outgrowth extension of physical education, shall be offered to elementary and middle school students to provide opportunities for students to compete in organized athletic activities at their own levels of ability with their grade level peers. Competition may take place within each school, as well as on a city-wide basis, at the direction of the principal and the Department of Recreation and Community Services.

To the extent possible, the intramural program shall be conducted throughout the schools, with no selection criteria except for students under mandates of the Wisconsin Interscholastic Activities Association. The major thrust of the program shall be at the middle school level.
