

# Long Term Plan: School Reconfigurations

- North Division will be the flagship high school
- Douglas will be the re-envisioned state-of-the-art middle school
- Franklin and Lafollette will remain as K-8 schools and Jackson will remain a K-5 school
- Auer Avenue, Hopkins-Lloyd, Keefe Avenue will become K-5 schools
- Green Bay will operate a Success Center for all schools in the District
- All K-5 schools will expand early childhood offerings

  - Facilities & Maintenance instrumental in physical move
  - Parent/Staff Meetings
- Middle School Programming for Douglas
- Participation in Early Enrollment Fair

- Planning and work has begun for Douglas Middle School Site

# 53206 Initiative: Supportive Services

- All schools have a 40 hour per week parent coordinator
- Additional substitute teachers are in the process of being hired
- Extra para professionals have been provided
- Trauma support specialist position for each site
  - Job description is being discussed and created
  - Space allocations have been determined per site
