The Administration is requesting authorization to extend the contract with Drive USA, Inc. d/b/a Arcade Drivers School for a driver education program. This contractor will be used to deliver classroom and behind the wheel instruction for the MPS Drive program and behind the wheel instruction for the Community-based Driver Education program.

MPS identified a large disparity in the number of young people within the City of Milwaukee who possess a driver's license. In an effort to eliminate potential barriers to obtaining a driver's license, the MPS Drive program was developed to offer free driver education to all age-eligible MPS students. Paired with the Community-based Driver Education program, young people throughout Milwaukee now have multiple access points to obtain a driver's license.

Contractor was chosen pursuant to RFP 1038, which closed on February 22, 2021. The original contract provided for two one-year options to extend if certain performance metrics were met. Drive USA Inc. d/b/a Arcade Drivers School met the performance metrics codified in the contract; therefore, MPS is exercising the first and second option years (Years 2 and 3) for the contract for a term of September 1, 2022 through August 31, 2024.

The total cost of the contract in Years 2 and 3 will not exceed \$2,956,525.00.
