## ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY 8.24

## STUDENTS OF LEGAL AGE

- (1) Eighteen-year-olds shall be subject to the same school rules as other students, except as enumerated below.
- (2) Eighteen-year-old students who move to Milwaukee independent of their parents may be admitted to the school. They may be eligible for indigent texts and free lunches as determined by their individual economic circumstances.
- (3) Students having attained the age of 18 can certify their own participation or withdraw from programs in which they were enrolled without parental consent. They can, upon attaining the age of 18, request a part-time work-study program, even if their parents previously refused to concur.
  - (4) School officials shall no longer require that absence excuses be signed by the parents.
- (5) Individuals who have attained the age of 18, if suspended, may negotiate their own readmission, and while the school may notify parents, they shall not, as a condition for reinstatement, compel the presence of the parents.
- (6) Students 18 years of age and older may be excused from school attendance without parental consent.
- (7) School officials may regulate out-of-school behavior only as it affects in-school behavior. The school administration can control the drinking of intoxicating beverages or other behavior while students are at school, while under the supervision of a school authority, or while engaged in a school activity. They may remove or cause to be removed individuals whose behavior indicates they may be under the influence of alcohol or other behavior-altering substances.
