Evidence of meaningful relationships between adults and students and community.  Evidence that teachers cocreated expectations, procedures, and agreements (matrix posted).  Evidence that the expectations, procedures, and agreements are implemented daily through teaching and practice (80% of staff).  Evidence of systems that students use to hold themselves and others accountable for positive behavior.  Various examples of students being acknowledged for positive behavior and are recognized daily for their worth (80% use school acknowledgment system 80% of the time).
