Wisconsin public schools are facing budget concerns because of insufficient state funding. Had state funding kept pace with inflation, MPS would have more than \$210 million in additional support annually. Also, students with disabilities, who make up 19% of the MPS student population, are significantly underfunded by the state by at least \$50 million annually.

Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP)

The Affordable Connectivity Program is designed to help families to afford the internet.

A federal program, the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP), provides a \$30/month discount on home internet service. As all schools in Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) participate in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), households with MPS students are automatically eligible for this discount.

Two internet providers in Milwaukee, Spectrum and AT&T, offer home internet service for \$30/month for households that qualify for the ACP.

This means that you can sign up for the ACP at ACPbenefit.org and then sign up for \$30/month internet service with Spectrum or AT&T.
